Dear Dr. Krishnan,

I had requested Dr. Ram Prasad, who visited Landour a few days ago with two gentlemen from the Central Water & Power Commission to consult me about a flood warning VHF radio system, to inform you that there is no news of a theoretical physics conference being held in Landour this summer. I got this information from the Asst. Garrison Engineer who visited Landour last week.

In view of the interview for Pileni Assistant Director posts, which is likely to be held in early May I have very reluctantly had to drop out of the Nanda Devi Expedition where I had hoped to carry out 75 Mc. propagation tests. (Last year I missed the interview while I was away to Everest.) However, I hope to carry out microwave studies at altitudes upto 16,000 ft. There is no published data on this subject.
