My Dear Dr Krishnam,

I learnt from Balifa who has come here for the I.R.C.C. Conference, that you were ill for some time. I am very sorry to hear that & I do hope it has nothing to do with your eye trouble.

I have now been examined by the Ophthalmic surgeon and his report read says that there is progression in the disease in spite of conservative treatment and so he also advocates operation. This will entail my being in the hospital for 6 weeks and then returning to India in a plaster cast. The cast however will be such that I can attend the labs. The trouble

is that the ² earliest they can
operate is about the end of this
month as both Surgeons have
to operate, and they are not
available together, before the
