Dear Dr. Krishnan,

Thank you very much for your letter of March 5th. I certainly want to see you very much. This is my plan. I shall leave Calcutta on March 16th by an evening train for Goya. The train leaves Calcutta about 7 p.m.. I shall arrive in Delhi at about 9 p.m. from Banaras on March 20th and then leave for Agra and Jaipur in early morning of 23rd, returning to Delhi the evening of 25th. On the morning of the 26th I shall leave by plane for Nepal via. Patna. I shall final return to Calcutta in the evening of 28th and leave for Japan on April 23rd. I understand from your letter that you will be away from Delhi from March 19th to March 23rd. Thus I do not know when I can see you. I do not want you to take the trouble of coming to Calcutta before I leave the city on 16th. I do not know if I can see you in Delhi in the evening of March 25th as I do not know when I shall return to Delhi. I am planning to come to Delhi from Jaipur by car. I am afraid it will be petty late when I arrive in Delhi. It seems that we shall have to see each other in New York.
