AIM: To encourage and improve the skills of our personnel and collaborators in the practice of indigenous, culture-based medicine for community health

PROGRAMME:

Successes and limitations in implementation.
The centres will also specify what they have been doing to study and promote herbal medicine/indegenous health practices.
2. Each centre will demonstrate the preparation of 3 herbal medicines and provide information on use and effect
3. Each centre displays herbarium sheets containing samples of medicinal plants commonly used in the area.
(Note:- If herbarium sheets are not easy to prepare then fresh samples of such medicinal plants should be brought for display at the Workshop)
4. Each centre should bring slides, posters and other Audio-Visual material for AV-demonstrations of health information and consciousness.


