International Heat and Power Exhibition in Stockholm, Sept. 22 - Oct. 2, 1949

An Instruments and Measurements Exhibition will be held in Stockholm from 22.9. to 2.10.1949 incl. At a preliminary investigation it appears that there is a very great interest also in a Heat and Power Exhibition. Therefore, it was decided to arrange an exhibition at the same time in adjoining buildings.

Above all the exhibition will elucidate the heat and power problems of the industry.

The exhibition is held under the auspices of The Royal Swedish Academy of Engineering Sciences and The Swedish Association of Engineers, and these bodies will simultaneously arrange an International Heat and Power Conference at which lectures and discussions on various heat and power subjects will be given by Swedish and Foreign experts.

Price of exhibition space is 50 Swedish crowns pro square metre. Of this sum 20% is allocated to the Conference. The stands will have a depth of 2,5 alt. 5 metres and the price includes painted walls of a height of 250 cm, and free electric current (220 V 1-phase - 380 V 3-phase AC 50 cycles) for demonstration apparatus.

The Royal Swedish Academy of Engineering Sciences and The Swedish Association of Engineers and Architects, Mechanical Section, have pleasure in inviting you to Heat and Power Conference 1949 to be held in Stockholm from 21 to 24 September.

The Conference will deal with heat and power subjects, particularly those elucidating the problems of industry. At the same time a Conference on Instruments and Measurements arranged by The Royal Swedish Academy of Engineering Sciences and the Association of Technical Physicists is being held in the same building. This Conference will a.o. deal with automatic combustion control.

An International Heat and Power Exhibition as well as an Instruments and Measurements Exhibition will also be held in Stockholm from September 22nd to October 2nd incl.

The program of the Heat and Power Conference has not yet been definitely settled, but preliminarily the following subjects will be dealt with:

- 1) Materials and Constructions for High Pressures and High Temperatures.
- 2) Feed Water Problems.
- 3) Modern Tendencies in Steam Power Plants design.
- 4) New Heat Apparatus and Appliances, especially for Pulp and Paper Mills, and the Iron and Steel Industry.

The organizers expect the participation of certain prominent Foreign and Swedish specialists. We ask you to inform us if you wish to give a lecture on one of the subjects mentioned or on any other related subject. The organizers, however, reserve themselves the right to arrange the lectures in suitable groups.

Lecturers are requested:

- 1) to state at the earliest opportunity the title of the lecture.
- 2) to send in an abstract, (200-300 words), of the lecture before September 1, 1949.
- 3) to hand in the lecture in full before September 24, 1949.
- 4) to state their wishes regarding lantern slide projectors, film projectors, and size of slides and films to be shown. Episcopes pictures should be avoided.

The publishing of the lectures is under consideration.

The official languages of the Conference are Swedish, English, German and French.

Membership fee is 10 Swedish crowns, to be paid before the opening of the Conference. This fee includes also admittance to the above mentioned exhibitions and the lectures on automatic combustion control at the Instrument Conference.

Instruments and Measurements Exhibition September 22 - October 2, 1949.

The International Instruments and Measurements Exhibition, previously planned to be held in Stockholm in May, has for various reasons been postponed till after the S:t Erik's Fair and will take place

from September 22 to October 2 incl., 1949.

The space preliminarily booked at present by exhibitors is equivalent to the area of the entire exhibition 1947 and in addition to this the two German zones have announced their intention to take part with together 45-50 exhibitors and an area of about 350-400 square metres altogether. Furthermore about 150 square metres have been booked by France. Many other countries, e.g. Switzerland, Holland, Belgium, Great Britain, U.S. and Czecho-Slovakia have shown an interest in the exhibition, which is expected to be about twice as large as the exhibition of 1947.

The exhibition will also this year be held under the auspices of The Association of Technical Physicists and The Royal Swedish Academy of Engineering Sciences and an international Conference on Instruments and Measurements will be arranged simultaneously by these two bodies, at which lectures and discussions on various subjects falling within the scope of the Conference will be given by Swedish and foreign experts.

Price of Exhibition Space is 50 Swedish crowns pro square metre. Of this sum 20% is allocated to the Conference. The stands will have a depth of 1,22 metres or 2,5 metres and the price includes painted walls of a height of 250 cm, and free electric current (220 V 1-phase - 380 V 3-phase alternating current 50 periods) for demonstration of exhibited instruments and apparatus.
