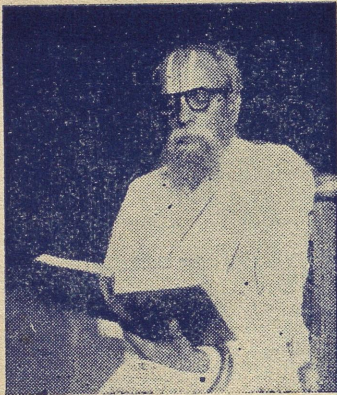

Dear Doctor Krishnan,

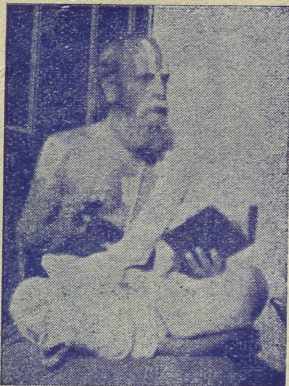
I am enclosing some pamphlets for your perusal, written by me and published by the Ramanuja Mission at Madras, in connection with the Sri Villiputtur agitation. After extensive tour of all places, it has become imperative that we have to build a new organisation to protect these sacred Temples from decay. To attain this object, a public meeting was held at Madras and the printed copies of the resolutions are enclosed. Fifty of our Holy places need immediate attention. The defects are some have no Pujas, others are in ruin, no festivals, some are being sold and caste mark being changed. There are several evils under which we suffer, and it is therefore necessary that you should take some interest in this matter. I have proposed that this Mission should be enlarged ^{for an 24 India scale.} and that you should be a Patron of this Grand work. I have visited all the places in company with Sri T. Narsimulu Naidu and delivered brilliant lectures to create enthusiasm, and a big conference coming off in the ^{last week of} April in Tinnevely district. We need your cooperation and blessings to a very large extent, and we are sure you will never fail.

I have a complaint against you, that you have not taken sufficient interest in honouring Sriman P.B.A. Swamy and that you should see that he is honoured before long. ^{The matter is with President Sri Rajendra Prasad. A long correspondence has ensued}

It is also the idea that that place should be the office of the Vaidhanas Sabha, & all our functions.

be decided in the annual meeting.

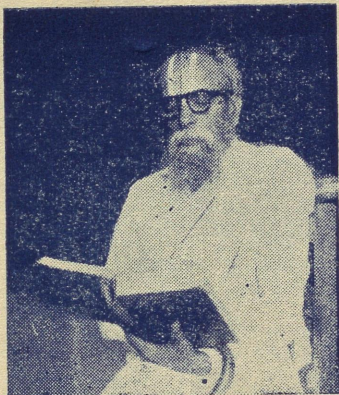
If no, what happens to the room now taken.

then we can make them pay. To begin
with the study should be free.

whether any forward step can be taken.
I met Justice Jagannathan, & he is in
entire agreement with you in any
action you propose. I await your direction.
