Thank you for your letter of the first of August.

For the last few years we have no longer been engaged in experimental genetics or in mutagenesis. Due to the great demand of routine investigations in medical genetics the lab is completely tied up with prenatal diagnoses and with human blood cultures. Research presently is only carried out in clinical genetics. I fear that this type of work would not suit your interests.
