





Sub:- Recruitment of one Professor in Mathematics-cum-Ballistics, in the Institute of Armament Studies, Kirkee, under the Defence Science Organization, Ministry of Defence.

With reference to the correspondence resting with your letter No. R4/54-55 dated the 29th April, 1955, I am directed to offer Dr. B.S. Madhava Rao, Principal and Professor of Mathematics, Central College, Bangalore, a temporary appointment of Professor in Mathematics-cum-Ballistics at the Institute of Armament Studies, Kirkee, under the Defence Science Organization, Ministry of Defence, on the ~~xxxx~~ terms and conditions mentioned below:-

- (i) His appointment will be for a period of 3 years in the first instance.
- (ii) He will draw pay at the rate of Rs.1,400/- (Rupees fourteen hundred only) per month in the scale of Rs.1000-50-1400 which will be inclusive of leave salary, pension etc. to be drawn separately from the Mysore Government. Only the balance of Rs.1,400/- will be drawn from the Ministry of Defence. In addition to this he will be entitled to allowances in accordance with rules in force from time to time.
- (iii) He is required to undergo a medical examination by the Medical Board at Bangalore. The standard of physical fitness shall be as provided in the attached copy of medical regulations. He will be required to pay the prescribed fee to the Medical Board at the time of medical examination, and his appointment will not be effected until and unless he is declared medically fit. The date, time and exact place of medical examination will be communicated to him direct by the Senior Surgeon in Mysore, Bangalore. No travelling allowance will be admissible to him in respect of journeys performed in connection with the medical examination.
- (iv) He will be on probation for a period of two years.
- (v) His appointment will be terminable on one month's notice on either side.
- (vi) He will be subject to conditions of service as applicable to temporary civilian Government servants paid from Defence Services Estimates in accordance with the orders issued by the Government of India from time to time.
- (vii) He will be required to serve anywhere in India.
- (viii) He will be entitled to any travelling allowance for joining the appointment.

If Dr. Madhava Rao accepts the offer on the terms and conditions detailed above, he should be asked to intimate his acceptance of the offer to the office of the Chief Administrative Officer, Ministry of Defence, immediately. If he is declared medically fit by the Board he should report for duty at the Institute of Armament Studies, Kirkee, under intimation to that office.

(vii) He will be required to serve anywhere in Mysore.
(viii) He will be entitled to any travelling allowance for joining the appointment.


