Members and Sessional Members have the right to contribute papers for reading at the Session of the Congress. Student Members must have their papers communicated by a Member, Honorary or Sessional Member. **In case of a paper in joint authorship, each author must be a Member of some category.**

Each paper should be accompanied by three typed copies of an abstract not exceeding 200 words and not containing any diagrams and formulae. The name of the Section for which the paper is meant, should be mentioned on each paper as well as on the abstract. Papers published or due for publication before the Session elsewhere will not be accepted. Copies of papers and abstracts may kindly be retained as it may not be possible to return them. Papers are to be sent to the General Secretary, Indian Science Congress Association, 64, Dilkhusa Street, Calcutta-17, so as to reach him not later than the 15th September, 1965.

From past experience it is seen that a single author, individually or in joint authorship, sometimes contribute too many papers, mostly concerned with points of details. It is, therefore, particularly requested that care may kindly be taken to cover the work done, in as small a number of papers as possible. While it may not be necessary to lay down any limit in regard to the maximum number of papers an individual Member may be permitted to submit, it would perhaps be admitted that it is difficult for any scientist to produce more than three or four papers in a year, including the ones in joint authorship with others, on genuine scientific work.

You are aware that in the present stage of planned development of the country science is bound to play its part in defence, industry, agriculture, nutrition and many other fields, and as such it is the duty of the Indian Science Congress Association to see that knowledge on these subjects is thoroughly elucidated and brought to the notice of the masses. For this work your full co-operation is indispensable. It is you who can increase the Membership of the Congress and bring forth all grades of scientists to work for the cause for which the Indian Science Congress Association stands.
