

Copy of letter No.21-202/56-Instt.I. dated the 16th Dec., 1957 from the Under Secretary to the Govt. of India, Ministry of Food & Agriculture, New Delhi to the Director, I.A.R.I., New Delhi-12.

Sub:-IARI. - APPOINTMENT OF DR. M.S. SWAMINATHAN TO THE POST OF CYTOGENETICIST -

I am directed to refer to the correspondence resting with your letter No.Ad/1/9/(2)39751, dated the 6th November, 1957, on the above subject and to say that on the recommendations of the Union Public Service Commission the President is pleased to approve of the continued appointment of Dr. M.S. Swaminathan to the post of Cytogeneticist (Class I) at the Indian Agricultural Research Institute, New Delhi in the scale of pay of Rs.600-40-1000-1000-1050-1050-1100-1150 on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The post is permanent.
2. He will be on two years probation.
3. His pay will be fixed in accordance with rules.
4. The post is non-pensionable but if he is already holding a permanent pensionable post, he will continue to enjoy his pensionary status.
5. The Government reserve the right to terminate his services at any time even after the period of probation is over, for professional inefficiency on the advice of persons of body competent to judge the scientific quality and out-turn of his work by giving three months notice.
6. The appointment would be subject to his being medical examination and verifications of Character and Antecedents if this has not already been done.

I am to add that the assessment report on the work of Dr. - Swaminathan should be made available to the Commission through this Ministry for a period of two years subsequent to his appointment. This report should include the remarks regarding the amount and quality of work done by him and how it was done, whether he was able to do it himself, whether he has initiative etc.
