1. Subject to the provisions of Chapter IV of the Wild Life
(Protection) Act, 1972 and the rules framed thereunder, in so
far as they relate to the regulation of any of the acts to be
performed within a Wildlife Sanctuary/National Park, permission
is hereby granted to M/s Dr. R. Sankaran, Scientist, Division of
Animal Ecology, Selim Ali Centre for Ornithology & Natural History, Vadodra
to enter/reside in Assess. Area of Pms. Bhavnagar, Junagadh, Rajkot, Jamnagar &
for the period of August 94 to - October 94
to S. Bhavnagar for the following purpose :-

- (1) Investigation or study of Wildlife and purposes ancillary or incidental thereto.
- (2) Photography/Filming.
- (3) Scientific Research. (Assess. Area Survey)
- (4) Tourism.
- (5) Transaction of lawful business with any person residing in the Wildlife Sanctuary/National Park.

3. The permit holder shall observe the rules and regulations appended herewith.

4. The permit shall be returned to the Chief Wild Life Warden, Gujarat State, Vadodra within seven (7) days of the expiry of the permit period with the account of work done etc.

5. One copy of the film shall be presented (free of cost) to this Deptt. for publicity purposes. An undertaking to this effect shall have to be made in writing before Conservator of Forests, Vadodra.

Accompaniment to Permit No. 35 dt. 16.8.94
issued in favour of Dr. R. Sankaran, Scientist, Division of
Avian Biology, Udaipur.

Rules and Regulations to be observed by a Permit Holder for entry/stay in the Wildlife Sanctuary/National Park:

- (i) He shall not move about in the forest area of the Wildlife Sanctuary/National Park except when accompanied by Departmental guide who will be provided on payment of the prescribed fees.
- (ii) He shall not carry or kindle a fire in any part of the Wildlife Sanctuary/National Park except within his prescribed camping site during the period from 1st Jan. to 30th June.
- (iii) He shall not carry any fire arms or poisonous substance inside ~~the~~ the Wildlife Sanctuary/National Park without the written permission of the Chief Wildlife Warden or any other Officer authorised by him in this behalf.
- (iv) No movements after dusk and upto dawn within the Wildlife Sanctuary/National Park shall be permitted.
- (v) Parking of vehicles will be allowed only on the prescribed parking plots.
- (vi) Permit holder will have to conduct himself only along prescribed routes, paths and areas and in no case they they will enter prohibited areas.
- (vii) Permit holder will not be permitted to carry noise generating equipment like Transistor, Radios, Musical instruments drums, record players, Tape Recorders etc.
- (viii) Within the limits of Wildlife Sanctuary/National Park, permit holder will have to conduct himself as silently as possible. Making of loud noises and groups singing is strictly prohibited.
- (ix) Feeding of animals, birds and other Wildlife by the permit holder within the Wildlife Sanctuary/National Park is prohibited.
- (x) The skulls and dead-body parts shall be dug out in the presence of Officer-in-charge of Wildlife Sanctuary/National Park and numbers so recovered shall be reported immediately to the concerned Conservator of Forests, and Chief Wildlife Warden, Gujarat. State.
