The roots of Indian Civilisation in the World.

1- Introduction

The age old Indian Civilisation, once spread in the entire world, start shrinking since last one thousand years, on account of the after effects of isolations of Indians from the rest of the world, after Mahabharat war, fought in India in about 3100 B.C. The acceptance of Christianity by European rulers and its imposition on the natives of the area conquered by them to establish their dynastis in the foreign land was the begining of the process. The same practice was followed by the muslim invaders. The conversion of Hindus into Christians and Muslims, were in very large scale with in last 500 years. Akbar the Great, in order to attract Hindus to cooperate in strengthening his Empire in India, evolved, Urdu, language (having Persian Scripts and words, mounted on Hindi Grammar) also he created a new religion based wholly on Islamic belief having same distorted and misinterpreted ^{faiths of} paths. Hindu religion in the name of Din-e-Ilahi, Urdu was accepted as official language. The knowledge of Urdu and acceptance of Din-e-Ilahi was the basic qualification for Govt. employment, award of jagirs and other benefits of nearness and loyalty to the Empire. The experiment of Akbar the Great proved to be very success ^{just}, not only in strengthening his empire, but also paved ^{way} ~~wing~~ for conversion of Hindus into Muslims at later stage. Akbar became great with cooperation of Hindus converted to the

path of loyalty to the Europe Emprere.

After the fall of Meghal empire, the loyalists^{sts} got refuge in the British rule, who took over India after Meghals. These loyalists^{loyalists}

Indians were bestowed with all type of benefits expected as a price for the loyalty to foreign rule, in the Country. Colonel Boden created a separated Deptt. called Boden Chair of Sanskrit in the University of Oxford for producing anti Indian literature. Colonel Boden the founder of the Chair stated in his will dt. August 15, 1811 AD, that the special object of their munificent bequest was to promote the translation^{ion} of Sanskrit scripture in such a way as to enable his countrymen to succeed in the conversion of the native of India to the Christian religion.

Lord Macalay the then Governor general to India, was made to believe that if any how, the Dharm and Sanskrit of Indians were destroyed then and then only they will be loyal to British rule.

Max Muller who was studying Sanskrit and Vedas in the University of Paris was appointed at a very high post of the Boden Chair in Oxford University in year 1855 AD.

Max muller will a highly paid team of Indian & British Scholars translated the Vedas, Purans, upnished and other Indians literature and English and reproduced after in corrupting the adulterations and mis interpretation suited to malign Vedas and distort India History, culture, and civilisation which was transmitted in the minds of Indian youths through the English medium education which was open-

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popularised.

The British rule was ended on 15th August 1947, leaving the entire administrations michronary in tact in the charge of the loyalist class with the hope of further ^{deterioration} ~~deterioration~~ of Indian culture moral and imposing an automatic check in the development of the country. After 33 years of the

independence the progress in this direction is much more than their expectations. If ~~the~~ ^{we} continue to shut ~~our~~ ^{our} eyes from the conditions prevailing in ~~our~~ ^{the} country, our religion, culture and the nation is bound to experience a great set back in very near future.

2- Creation of World

There is diversity in views available from different source of the knowledge in respect the age and process of creation of world.

The source of the knowledge are Mythological books and the scientific studies. 2.15 Fifth day. God Commanded.

2.17 Seventh day God finished, what he had been doing and stopped working.

2.18 Beside above there is another story of creation of 'ancient world' by the Lord God. The area of the world ~~extends~~ ^{extends} upto Arabia Mesopotamia, Asia Minors and North Egypt.

2.181 When the Lord God made the Universe there were no plants on the earth and no seeds had sprouted because he had not sent any rain and there was no one to cultivate the land, but water would come up from beneath the surface, and water the ground.

2.182 Then the Lord God took some soil from the ground and formed a man out of it.

2.183 Then the Lord God planted a garden in Eden in the east and there he put the man he had formed. A Stream from river, Euphrat was flowed in Eden, and watered the garden. The distance of Eden from river Euphrat is about 1000 miles (one thousand miles). The stream was an about one thousand miles diversion command.

Abraham was born at about 2000 B. C.

The ancient world was created by the Lord God in about $(2000+1946)=3936$ B. C. which is about 5826 say 6000 years ago from current period.

2.191 The Lord God could not succeed in getting the possession of the ancient world said to have been created by him. He could manage to possess a piece of barren land in Ancient World in east of Eden in which he planted the garden of Eden and started cultivation in the barren land through Adam, the man created by him. Infact the Lord God was a land Lord of a piece of barren land in the east of Eden and the Adam became his first sub ~~tenant~~. ^{tenant}.

2.193 The descendents of Adam later on, propagated^t to claim the Lord God as the +God father of their race and claimed the leadership over the poor people of their own ^{race} place who became slaves^e to the rulers of the time. The race of the Adam is called Israclits.

2.20 Hindu Mythology.

According to Hindu Mythology the concept of creation of Universe is described as below.

2.210 Narain, is the Almighty Supreme power who in the beginning of creation of Universe entering himself into the Nature, disintegrated it. The disintegrated Nature produced the Supreme Element (Mahat^tva) which consequently^y produced the 'Properly' (Alankar). Alankar created Sky. Sky created wind. Wind created Fire. Fire created water, and water created earth.

2.211 Narain put his Semen in water which produced an ^{golden} ~~golden~~ Egg, which gave birth to Brahma, a representative of Narain Himself

2.212 Brahma, divided himself in two parts one part represented the male and the other female. The cohabitation of this male and female gave birth to Ist Man known as Swambhu Manu and Ist Women known as Satyarupa and they are the originator of the man kind.

2.220 The life of Brahma is one hundred Brahm years, one day of which is equal to one thousands Chaturyugi. The period of one Chaturyugi is as follows.

4.32 Million years.

2.221 Brahma will work in day time and will sleep during night. The nature this will be active during day time and in-
 active or dead during Brahma's night. The period of activity (life) in Brahma's day time will be $1000 \times 4.32 = 4320$ M.Yrs. The world will remain lifeless for 4320 million years in the Brahma's night. One day of Brahma is called 'Kalp'.

2.222 One day of Brahma i.e. 4320 million years will have fourteen manu races one after another the period of one Manu race is known as 'Manwanter' having seventy one Chaturyugi period or $4.32 \times 71 = 306.72$ M.Y.

2.230 From the beginning of present "Satt Barah" Kalp, till to day six manu have completed their term one after the other and seventh manu known as "Babastva" manu is the forefather of the present race. In the present Babastva Manwanter twenty seven 'Chaturyugies' have passed and the present twenty eight Chaturyugi has completed three yugs and the fourth yug, the Kalyug has completed 5080 years so far.

2.231 The age of present yug, Chaturyugi, Manwanter and Kalp is worked out as below.

2.31 The geoloical evidence are available
in rocks and the fossilized relies of plants
and animals that many of the rocks contain.

2.32 The age of the Earth is 4500 Millions
years or more. Almost nothing is known of
conditions during Ist one thousand million
years before the earth crust consolidated,
Only a period of 600 millions is traceable
with accuracy. About 570 millions years ago,
The earth begining as a whirling globe of
inter stellargas, Passed through a liquid
state and formed a solidified crust. Thick
steamy atmosphere surrounded the planet.

As the earth surface cooled, water vapour condensed as rain to produce rivers and seas. The surface now formed a barren landscape of mountains, deserts, volcanoes and steaming lava fields. This period in geological language is classified as Pre-Cambrian period. The life originated in the warm seas in the form of sea weeds, and soft bodied invertebrate animals. Man and animal appeared in pleistocene period about two million years ago. The

2.33 The X-section of the earth is as follows :

1- Crust This is the upper most part, consisting of granite rock layers in the continents and Basaltic layers beneath the oceans. The rocks are Mohorovicic, having discontinuity with the mantle or (earth cover). The pressure at atmosphere is 1-atmosphere.

2. Mantle.

It is compressed iron magnesium silicate probably rigid to a depth of 450 miles.

3- Possible Sulphide and Oxide shell.

a- Outer Core

It consists of Nickel Iron probably molten. Pressure at surface of core is 1.5 million atmospheres.

b- Inner Core.

It consists of Nickel Iron, probably solid. Pressure at earth Centre about 3.5 million atmospheres and the temperature is 3 to 4000°

The continental parts of the Earth's Crust are compact of ~~may~~^{many} different kind of rocks have the density and composition of granite as a whole, called (Sial) because of the predominance of ~~silica~~^{Silica} and alumina in its composition.

The (Sial) floats on a denser layer called (basaltic)

In continental areas the thickness of granite and basalt together is about 20 to 25 miles, In oceans the thickness of basalt ~~above~~^{about} is 3 miles. Granite extends to a depth of 1800 miles. The outer core is ~~1310~~¹³¹⁰ miles and the inner core 850 miles.

The wide range of variation in material, density temperature and pressure inside to the Earth Crust and outer weather effect on outer crust ~~and outer~~^{are} responsible for change of geological geographical and living condition on earth. In some period the conditions for favourable for life and in some period unfavourable to make the earth life less. The availability of marine fossils of limestone on the ~~summit~~^{Summit} of everest show, that ~~some~~ times back the ~~summit~~^{Summit} of Everest was sea bed.

2.40 Scientific Studies.

The article published in "Northern" India. Patrika "Allahabad" dt. 28th February 1980, is self explanatory and is reproduced as below.

2.21. "Towards Leo A space O dyssey."

New Delhi Feb. 27

American Scientists have found that, the earth its Solar System, and the milky way galaxy are travelling through the universe at more than 1.6 million Km. per hour in the direction of the constellation Leo reports PTI. Another Surprising finding was that while every thing within the universe is rotating, the universe itself is not.

The findings were made by research at the university of California and Locksheed Electronic company space system Division near Houston Texas.

The Scientists have been mapping for the last three years the hot spots in the skies of the Northerns and Southern Hemispheres with the help of an extremely precise thermometer carried almost the high flying U.2 air craft. The high altitude flights with the thermometer aboard are being conducted as part of the project to find out the exact age of universe.

Scientists believe that the Universe was born ten to fifteen Billion years (10,000 Million years) ago in the Cataclysmic ~~Explosion~~ ^{Explosion} of a hot dense mass of matter.

The sensitive thermometer about the aircraft has been measuring minute temperature variations in energy released at the time of explosion.

This and another Americans study employing newly developed 150 topos dating techniques hope to make precise estimates of just when the big bang occurred "

2.50 Correlation between geological and Scientific studies and Hindu Mythology.

2.51 The structure of Earth is like a bomb, in which the outer crust is its shell, and inner and out cores of the ^{sulphide} ~~oxide~~ shell are the explosive materials under it. The moving planets balance the position and movement of Earth, ~~balance the position & movement of Earth~~, balance of gases and the climate produce, the weather effect and to create condition favourable to the life on earth.

The inner explosive material, which is under enormous pressure having extremely high temperature is always in the process of rapid chemical actions and has a constant tendency to explode. Some times it functions the upper crust come out as a lava.

The constant weather effect, ^{to} and the upper crust to contract and to compress the inner explosive which consequently increase the temperature the pressures and accurate the speed of chemical action. Ultimately the bomb explodes and entire material contained in the earth is converted into gases and the life on the earth crushed is vanished.

Again begins the cooling process, the upper crust solidified the vapours condensed to produce rain water and the process of generation of life in the earth crust starts. +This Phenomenon of explosion and cooling the life and lifeless period on the earth is eternal.

2.52 According to Hindu Mythology the age of Brahma about 52 years, and earth from its beginning has undergone $365 \times 52 = 18980$ say 19000 such changes from beginning, the earth had life 19000 times and same was the period when there was no life on the earth.

2.53 The geological studies which are based as probability of fossilized evidence and other approximate could penetrate in the knowledge only upto current change of earth from gacious state to the current period, which according to Hindu Mythology occurred with in 1956 to 6276 million years and the period assessed by geologists as 4500 million years ^{lies} ~~lives~~ within this period.

2.54 Scientists with more accurate man made instrument, could penetrate into the knowledge upto 2nd change when the earth was in gacious stage, this period according to Hindu Mythology was 10596 to 14916 million years ago. The period assessed by Scientist as Ten to 15 Billion years ^{lies} ~~is~~ within this period.

2.55 The findings of Hindu Mythology are based on the following

1- The Sayings of 'Rishis', the representative of the supreme power. The Narain who were born in the world in different periods and spent their life among the people.

2- Visualizing the past incidents will the power of "Divine Vision" got developed in the man on account of 'Yog Sadhna' for a very long period.

3- The correct assessment of the influence of of movement of plannets on human and other lives, and ^{on} ~~are~~ weather and envirement, with the knowledge of Jyotish Shashtra.

The findings of Hindu Mythology, thus are so accurate and reliable, that this extent of accuracy is not possible in man made instrument

3.0 Man Races.

According to the publication refered in Para. 2.30, the Indigeneous races of the world are the ^ucaucasoids, mangroids and Negroids. The Australloid has developed in an isolation from an Archaic white form. The American Indian is derived from unspecialized mangloid. Some peopple such as Malanesian, results from the mixture of the basic stocks. Others for example the Basques, the Bushmen, and the veddas are probable very ancient population which have largely escaped this process of hybridization ^{by} geographical isolation. The Veddas are the native of Ceylone and extreme South India, and the Basques are the native of Spain.

3.10 The basic Characteristics of the main races are described as below.

3.11 ^{Caucasoid} Caucasoid. Their colour of eyes, hair and skin is light. Hair extremely sine, medium wavy, or straight beard and body hair usually abundant. Nose high and narrow lips, thin blood group more A than B. They are in habited in entire Europe, West and south Russia, entire middle East, Pakis-tan, India (except Himalya region and eastern part) Egypt and North Africa along the coast of Mediterania sea and Madagascar.

3.12 Archaic White. The group is separated from the main race before complete specialisation and developed in geographical isolation. They are inhabited in Australia.

3.13. Mongoloid ^{Ita} The colour of eyes brown, hair black skin yellow. Eye form starting and not much recessed, mongoloid eye fold. Hair texture coarse, very little beard and body hair. Nose moderately broad low bridge. ~~Bellid~~ Blood group high in B, the race is found in Asia in east of the area occupied by the caucasoid, East Indies, Newzealand, Alaska and North of U. S. A.

3.14 American Indians.

Group separated from the main race before complete specialisation and developed in geographical isolation. They are found in South America, Central America and U. S. A. of North America.

3.15 Negroid. Their colour of eyes, hair & skin is dark brown to black. Hair texture woolly beard and body hair sparse. Nose broad, low bridge lips thick everted, Blood group high in Rho (CDe). They are found in entire Africa in South of the area occupied by the caucasoid and Madagascar.

3.20 The oldest fossil men are the Pithecanthropⁱ, found in Java and North China are related to the period 0.4 million year ago. The distribution of man population in ^{the} world about 0.1 million year ago is shown as below.

3.21 Africa Continent. The entire continent was fully populated and there was no population in Madagascar.

3.22 Asia.

The entire half of the area on Southern side was fully populated. There was no population in U. SSR North of Caspian Sea, North and South Korea, north China, Mongolia, Japan and Phillipines.

3.23. Europe.

Except British Iselands, Norway, Sweden, Denmark and U. S. B. R. the entire Europe had population of mankind.

3.24. North, Central and South America.

It was unpopulated.

3.25 Austrillia, New Guinea and Newzeland.

There was no population.

3.30 It is evident from the above facts, that the three main races of the mankind, viz caucasoid, Mangeloid and Negroid were existing and were spread, in about half on the land in the world at about 0.1 million years ago. They were living in Asia, Europe and Africa only in warm areas and there was no population in cold climate. The population has progressed toward cold climate, from the population of warm areas afterwords. It is mystry why America and Austrillia were un populated, although the climate and the land was favourable for the development of population.

3.31 The fact that, in the period about 26 million years ago, the ~~period~~ elephants steadily increasing in size spread from Africa, into Europe, Asia and North America, clearly proves that Africa, Asia and North America, were fully populated about 26 million year ago, and they

were quite advance in the knowledge of Navigation, transport business management and live stock and they were in touch with each others as.

1. The way to America from Asia & Africa is either through bering straight or through Atlantic Ocean and both the cases the use of ship is a must to cross the Ocean.
2. American has full knowledge of the utility and importance of the Elephant which nececiated the transfer of Elephant from Africa and Asia.
3. The African and Asians had been competant enough to catch the elephant from the forest, tame, maintain transport to America and to Safe it.

3.32 The article published in Times of India dt.8 Feb.1980 is reproduced as below.

"Fossils of oldest connecting ape".

New fossil evidence indicate a small ape like creature, which lived thirty million years ago is the oldest known common an easter of man and apes, according to a Duke University Anthropotogist report AP.

Dr. Elwyn L-Simons, head of Duke Centre for the study of primate biology and History said at a news conference on wednesday, that he and his colleagus have determined that the animal lived in a complex social group defended by large males. The creature is known as "aegyptopithecus Zeuxis" which means "Connecting ape of Egypt" Dr. Simon said

He said study of aegyptothecas, fossil during last three years as strikingly clarified how the fossile get into the pattern of evolution of ape & man.

The discovery was made in recent exploration of Sahara desert in Egypt South west of Cairo The expedition was supported by National Science foundation and the Egyption Geological Survey.

The living conditons for an ape in Sahara to live are quite unfarourable and such the ape can not reach Sahara at its own accord. The said fossil therefore certainly is the fossil of an tamed ape and has been brought by the man from dense forest of Central Africa to the desert of Sahara, which ~~clearly~~ ^{clearly} show that the said area of Sahara had elite and presprerous population. The ape was brought for the pleasure of the ruler of the time or for public intertainment was kept in a Zoo-there.

It shows that the people about 30million year ago were prosperous, well advanced and elite.

3.33 The text of the interview, with Prof. G. R. Sharma Head of Department of Ancient History Culture and Archeology, Allahabad University after his recent visit to U.S.S.R. published in Northern India Partika Allahabad in the 1st week of August 1980 is reproduced as below.

" Slav Kinship to Sanskrit.

Allahabad August 1-There is cultural similarity between the U.S.S.R. and India since three to four lac years, when none of these countries existed as political entities and the human beings were in wandering stage report P. T. I. Claiming this Prof. G. R. Sharma head of the Department of Ancient History culture and Archeology Allahabad University told newsmen that cultural and Archeological similarity between the two countries was found towards the end of the stone age and also in bronze age. Elaborating his claim, Prof. Sharma said that similarity in grammar between Slav root of all regional languages of the U.S.S.R. and Sanskrit ^{mother} ~~month~~ of regional Indian languages was just like similarity between Hindi and Bengali or Hindi and Gujrati.

The period specified in the above article is related to the period referred in Para 3.20 which clearly is an evidence of existence of Mongoloid, and Caucasoid races in Asia about 0.4 million year ago.

3.40 Migration of the population from one country or continent to other was occurred in different periods, the reason was the disbalance of population, Search of better prospects of living,

conditions and establishing kingdoms etc.

3.41. In several waves of migrations from Asia to America the Mongoloid and Indians reached and settled in American continent about 15000 to 20,000 years ago Mongoloid settled in Northern region which is very cold, and the Indians settled in the region South of it where the climate was warm, and there was scope for agriculture and developing live stock. The Indian races settled in America were later named as Olmec, Zapotec, Teahuanaco, Toltec, Aztec and Incas. Their important events in the History are as follows.

- 1- The Olmec Indian Civilization was known for Mosaics and Jewel making in central and South America from 900-700 B. C.
- 2- The major settlement of Olmec Indians occurred in Laventa from 600-400 B. C.
- 3- The first Zapotec Indian civilization was known for representations of Gods in fulso of clay urns from 350 to 100 B. C. They were main builder of mountain top city of Monte Alban, lasted till 14th century A. D.
- 4- Teahuanaco Indian civilization established in Bolivia in 300-500 A. D.
- 5- Toltic Indians took over the 'Teotihuacan' in 900-1200 A. D. and have built superb cities such as Tula, temple of plumed serpent.
- 6- Aztec the militant Indian civilization started in 1300 AD. and they under Monte Zuma, dominated Mexico in early 16th Century AD.

7- Incas Indians ruled from Columbia to North Chile in 1400 AD. They developed efficient political system and have constructed the temple of Sun at Cuzco.

In Central and South America many Indians civilizations succeeded one and another. All were notable for their architecture and arts. The development of hieroglyphic writing, astronomical system calendar expressionist and art in Mexico from 600 - 400 B.C. and the construction of Pyramids of Sun and moon, speak high of the Indian civilization in Mexico. The last indian dynasties of Aztec and Incas were overthrown in the early 16th century by the Spaniards who then divide the country between themselves and the portuguese, and imposed the Roman Catholic religion on Indians. The 'Peso' the Marwari pronunciation of 'Paiza' the monetary unit in Argetina, Bolivia Columbia, Cuba, Dominican Republic and Uruguay is the remain of Indian civilization in American continent.

3.42 There had been a very massive migration specially of Europeans to America, Africa and Australia continents with in past three hundred years mainly for political and economical and religions reasons, which are described as follows

1- Europeans to U.S.A.

A- About 0.5 million people of Great Britain migrated in 17th century settled in New England Virginia and Mary land some settled in west Indies In 18th century about 1-5 million Irish and scots followed the footsteps of the people

2. European to Canada.

During 17th Century the Quebec province was settled by French from 1600 to 1667 about 5.75 million Europeans, especially the British settled in Canada.

3. Europeans to South America. From 1890 AD. to 1920, the Spanish, Portuguese and Italians settled in Brazil (1.5 million) and Argentina (3.0 million)

4. The Slave Trade. About 20 million slaves from west Africa were moved to work in tobacco, sugar and coffee plantation of Caribbean and Brazil from 16th to 19th century many of them moved to cotton fields of U.S.A.

5. Europeans to Australia and New Zealand. First white people settled in Australia in 1788. Between 1901 to 1920 about 0.4 million of U.K. settled in Australia from 1945 to 1965 0.5 million from U.K. settled in Australia. The New Zealand has followed much the same pattern but on smaller scale.

6. Europeans to Africa

About 0.4 million Europeans settled in Africa from 16th to 20th century.

7. Chinese to Other Parts.

In 19th century about 9.5 million Chinese ^{migrants} ~~migrants~~ settled in Malaya, Indonesia, Burma and Ceylone. About 0.2 million settled in U.S.A.

8. Indians to Malaya & Africa.

Historically Calcutta is 200 years old, but Geologists trace its territorial existence dating back to miocene, six to twenty six million year ago reports U.N.I.

This has been revealed in a paper by Mr. Shyamal Kanti Chakraborty of the Indian Museum here in a recent seminar on Calcutta, organised by Calcutta Urban society.

The recovery of about 200 gold coins belonging to the Gupta era from Kalighat in 1783 shows that the region thrived well during the golden period.

The discovery of Oyster Shells in the Dalhousie square area about 80 year ago has let the geologists to believe that the territorial region belongs to the miocene the paper said. Mr. Chakraborty said Calcuttas link with the geological times has been further confirmed following the discovery of another shell similar to Oyster from Diamond Harbour area recently.

Semifossilised bones of ante lope and horse of sub recent geological age (10,000-15,000) years discovered at Jadavpur on the southern fringe of the city early this year also support this theory.

The Oyster Shells from the Dalhansie Square area are now preserved at the British Museum in London.

6. Religion.

effecting adversely on the economic condition and prosperity of rich people and the priests. This act of Jesus annoyed the priests. They arrested him produced him before Roman Governor with the charge that Jesus is ^{declaring} ~~disgr~~ ing him self as son of God and is claiming the leadership of Israelite. He was found guilty and was ~~sentenced~~ ^{sentenced} to death and his body was removed from the grant to ~~some~~ unknown place. The poor followers could do nothing to save their Saviour.

His disciples in order to console and keeping unite his followers started propagating the story of Resurrection of the dead body of Jesus. The action of the disciples again annoyed the Jesus (pharss) priests, who ^{had} important position in Roman empire to deal with the people of their religion.

6.21 Sant a jew born in Tarsus in Cilicia who came to Jerusalem as a student of Gamattiel, was deputed by the priests at Jerusalem to go the Damascus ^{and} ~~and~~ ^{away} ~~west~~ the followers of Jesus. While soul was in way to Damascus, he planned to change his loyalty and so when he reached Damascus he started preaching in ^{favor} of Jesus of Nazareth. In about 600 B. C. Lao Tse, founded Taoism which teaches belief in the harmony and goodness of nature.

Confucius a Chinese philospher evolved the theory of confucians thoughts in year 479 B.
