Dear Mr. Rajam,

I have had an informal talk with some of my colleagues regarding the Madras Institute of Technology. We feel that before coming to a decision on the application of the Institute for assistance from the Tata Trusts, it is necessary that we should get an independent report by an expert of standing regarding the organisation and working of the Institute. I have accordingly requested Dr. H. J. Bhaba, F.R.S., to visit the Institute and make a report to the Trustees. He has kindly agreed to do so, but as far as he can tell at present, it will not be possible for him on account of his other engagements to visit Madras before June next. A decision on your application therefore will have to stand over until about the middle of this year.
