
Dear Dr. Joshi,



Dear Dr. Joshi,

I am writing this with respect to the efforts by the Technology Information Forecast and Assessment Council (TIFAC) of the Department of Science and Technology, Govt. of India, New Delhi, in developing a vision for the agricultural situation in India by 2020. TIFAC has started this effort with Prof. S.K. Sinha, Director, Water Technology Centre, IARI as the chairman of the committee to develop a forecast on Agriculture. This committee felt that the issues related to crop improvement shall be discussed at a meeting to be held towards the end of March, 1995, most likely at the University of Agricultural Sciences, GKVK, Bangalore 560 065.

It is proposed that in this meeting several issues such as the food demands by 2020 both for local consumption and export, profile of the food consumption of Indian population as linked to the probable economic growth of the country by 2020, the needs arising thereby, the technology required to meet them, the technology to be nourished/developed, the crop improvement and biotechnology that might be available / required then etc would be discussed. These are but a few of the multitude of issues that need to be considered in the process of developing a vision for agriculture in India by 2020.


We propose to initiate this discussion with a series of talks by invited resource personnel from different areas of agriculture, food technology, crop improvement, management and administration.


Dear Dr. Joshi,




