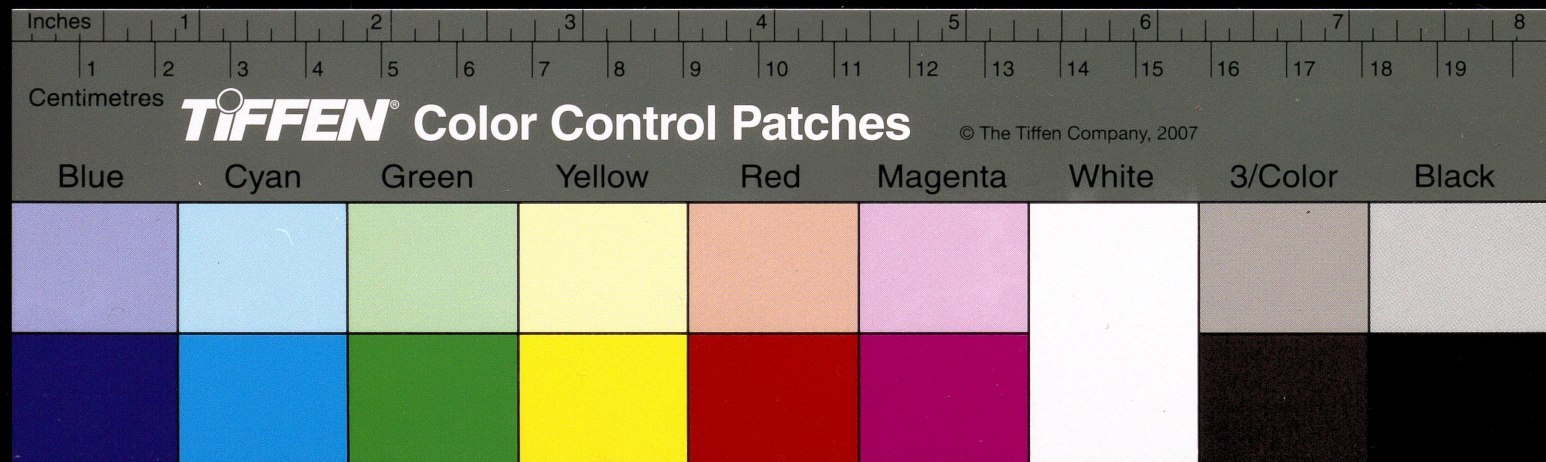
I hope you are keeping well.

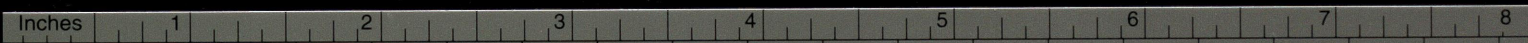

Please convey my heartfelt good wishes to the bride and the groom, and also to Mrs. Madhava Rao.

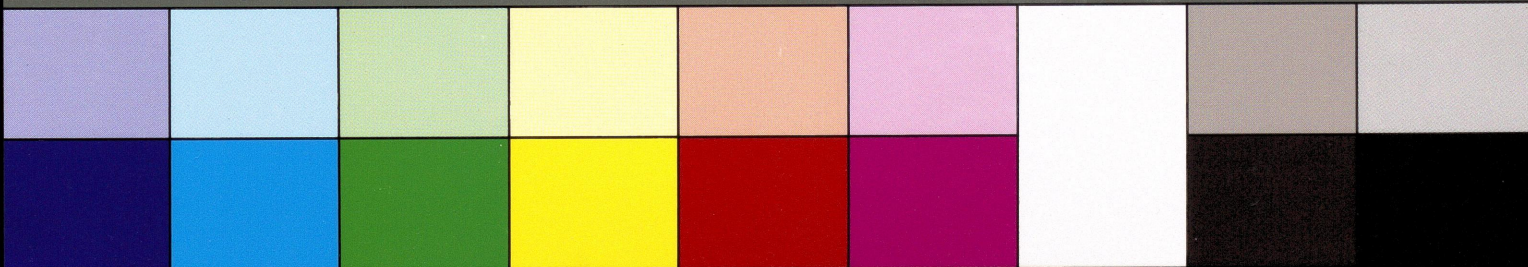
