You may like to have the list of the new F.R.S's which is attached. Drummond is Professor of Biochemistry at University College London and scientific adviser to the Ministry of Food. Kidd is a botanist and head of the Low Temperature Research Station of the Food Investigation Board of the D.S.I.R., at Cambridge. McSwiney is a physiologist and Dean of the St. Thomas' Hospital Medical School. Marrian is a biochemist and Professor of Medical Chemistry at Edinburgh. Polanyi is professor of physical chemistry at Manchester. Sand is a zoologist and works in the physiological Section of the Marine Biological Laboratory at Plymouth. Stanier is a mechanical engineer, was Chief Engineer to the British railways, and is now one of the three Scientific Advisers to the Minister of Production. Tiegs is an Australian zoologist. Van der Bijl I believe is a South African electrical engineer and a Foreign Member of the National Academy of Science, Washington. The rest I do not know.
