Sir,

As you are aware this Institute has undertaken a long term project for "The High Altitude Measurements of different components of cosmic radiation by balloons". Under this project, the Institute proposes to send a party of workers to make the high altitude flights from Delhi in October this year. This party will require working space and I am to request you to help us in the matter by providing suitable working accommodation in the National Physical Laboratory. For the work, a room 20' x 30' will be required and an additional room say 200 sq.ft. in area for storing materials.

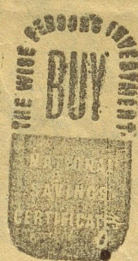
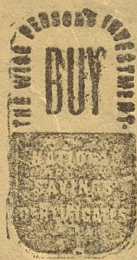
I shall be grateful if you can see your way to grant us both these requests.




