Dear Sir,

It is for quite sometime that I lost contact with you. Hope all is well with you and your works. Mrs. Gandhi wanted me to officially write to you about the proposed corridor for the elephants in West Bengal. But the Ministry of External Affairs has some reservations about the proposal and I feel it may be better to wait for the Indo-Bhutan meeting proposed to be held in October. However, I would like to discuss about this matter whenever you may be at Delhi.

Here I find myself badly webbed in the bureaucratic tangle and I am unable to do anything worthwhile. Also the financial position is seriously tight, which stands on way of virtually everything I want to do. Then there is a total lack of appreciation and priority about wildlife related needs and plans. The Forestry & Environment as a whole is granted a back seat, but wildlife is totally obscure. I am left with little time (less than two years) and within this period nothing will

probably work out, as I had been trying to do. Besides, there are other problems too which is nagging the ministry and obstructing works. You may be able to realise. Mrs Gandhi has been isolated and the isolation is complete, mainly due to her ~~wonder~~ uncompromising approach to problems, which she reads well, to my understanding.

But I am a professional and naturally all the obstacles disheartens me. For reasons for which I left Assam, are vary much alive even here to my frustration. Besides, I have added some more personal problems too, like my elder son still remains to be admitted.

Secretary, Sri Prashad, does not like my going out on tours and puts excuse like economy, though he himself has gone on 4/5 trips abroad since April. He does not think it necessary that India should send someone even for the I.U.C.N. general assembly or the F.A.O. seminar on management of Protected areas, which may not be accepted even by a total cynic. The main reason seems to be that Mrs. Gandhi will probably like to send me and may be I will say something, which may not reflect his thoughts. It's strange how personal differences may damage national interests!

All this and more has forced me to seek some opening somewhere beyond the narrow outlook, which I may never find. Anyway, I had applied for the post of the secretary General, C.I.T.E.S. which is likely to be decided in October.

How are you sis? I am quite well here.

Dear Shri Dutta,

When I was posted as Chief Conservator of Forest(G), Assam, 1988, I had made some representations to the Government of Assam (vide CCF's No.PG 94 of 25.11.88) regarding my claim for the post of Principal Chief Conservator of Forest, Assam which had been created, vide Assam Govt. Notification No.FRE 90/87/49 dated Dispur the 30th September 1988. This was again followed up by another representation vide CCF(G)'s No.PG 94, dated Guwahati the 22nd February 1989. Copies of both these representations are enclosed for ready reference.

In this connection, I am constrained to point out that despite my frequent discussions and requests to the then Secretary, Forests, Secretary, Department of Personnel and the Chief Secretary, Assam, no response whatsoever could be obtained, though all the above officers verbally admitted that prima facie my representation deserved consideration!

I would like to point out that during April, 1988 a similar post of PCCF was created in Meghalaya, Shillong and Shri A. Wallong, who had been posted as CCF, Meghalaya at that time was duly promoted to that post. Assam - Meghalaya being a joint cadre for the Indian Forest Service, it was required as per cadre rule to have J.C.A. clearance. Also the selection should have been carried out from a panel of eligible candidates. Shri Wallong being junior most in interse seniority in the 1962 $\frac{1}{2}$ batch of I.F.S. officers of this cadre, his case could not have been considered if these legal steps had been taken. Because since Shri D.P. Neog and Shri K.K. Baruah were under suspension at that time, the next senior officer (i.e. the undersigned) should have been considered for this post for the sake of justice and fair play. No J.C.A. clearance also was taken for the promotion of Shri A. Wallong.

However, since Shri Wallong, who is junior to me in this joint cadre, had been promoted nontheless, I should have been given protection of my eligible pay scale, which is the minimum that Govt. of Assam is duty-bound to do.

But strangely enough, when later on (in Sep'88) a post of PCCF, Assam was created and I was holding charge of the post of CCF (G) at that time, Govt. of Assam did not grant me promotion even to this post for more than one year since creation of the post, for some inexplicable reasons. And not even a few lines in reply was received to my representation.

Meanwhile, I have come to Delhi on deputation and joined here in the Ministry of Environment & Forests on 23rd April, 1990 as Additional Inspector General of Forests (Wildlife), on being formally selected by the Government of India. I wonder what could have stood on way of my selection as PCCF, Assam on regular basis, even though the promotion of my junior Shri Wallong on an earlier reason for granting me the scale of pay, which is admitted in all services.

May I therefore hope that you will be kind to look into this much delayed and probably neglected subject and grant me the due, that I am legally entitled to and oblige me thereby. I may mention here that I am going into superannuation next year, which may also kindly kept in mind.







Subject: Allotment of ~~general pool accommodation to the Honorary Advisors, Chairmen of Public Sector Undertakings, Corporations, Chairmen or Members of the Committees and the like.~~

The undersigned is directed to say that as per present policy Honorary Advisors, Chairmen of Public Sector Corporations, Consultants, Chairmen or Members of the Committees and the like are not eligible for allotment of general pool accommodation. Nevertheless requests are sometimes made to the Dte. of Estates for providing general pool accommodation to them. The matter has therefore been reviewed by the Cabinet Committee on Accommodation in its meeting held on 26.10.90 and it has been decided that ~~Honorary Advisors, Chairman of Public Sector Undertakings, Chairman or Members of the Committees and the like will not be considered for allotment of accommodation from the general pool Officers who are appointed to such posts after retirement shall also not be allowed to retain general pool accommodation being held by them and in such cases Min./Deptt. concerned shall arrange the accommodation direct from the market.~~

2. ~~It has also been decided that no commitment should be made for allotment of accommodation in terms and conditions of appointment of officers of Public Sector Undertakings by different Ministries/Departments for allotment of general pool accommodation.~~

3. So far as Consultants are concerned, it is stated that the guidelines as laid down vide O.M. No. 12028(2)/84 Pol.II dt.17.2.88 would continue to be in force.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 2nd November, 1992 on the subject mentioned above and to seek urgent clarifications of the followings:-

From the communication received from Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, it is noted that the retired officer, Shri S. Deb Roy has started contributing to the scheme u.e.f. February, 1987 only, while in fact, the scheme has come into effect from 1.1.1982. In view of the fact that deductions towards the scheme has started from February, 1982, a doubt has arisen as to whether the retired officer has been admitted to the scheme u.e.f. 1.1.1982 itself. In accordance with the provisions of the scheme, an employee who was in service on 1.11.80 ~~was in service on 1.11.80~~ was required to exercise option in Form No.3 which were to be pasted in the Service Book of the employee concerned and the Member shall be required to be informed in Form No.1, the date of his enrolment, the subscription to be deducted and the benefits to which he would be eligible. According to the scheme, the employees who were already in service on 1.11.80 were initially allowed to opt out of the scheme and the option once exercised or not exercised was final. However, the employees who opted out of the scheme initially, were given opportunity time and again to come over to the new scheme on written request from them in the prescribed form and they were enrolled as members of the scheme from the 1st January of the next year. Last such opportunity was afforded to exercise option upto 31st December, 1986 to become members with effect from 1.1.1987.

2. In respect of Shri S. Deb Roy, it was noted that deductions towards the scheme have started only from February, 1987. You are, therefore, requested to thoroughly examine the Service Book, the Personnel file and other relevant records ~~on the subject~~ available both in the Forest Department and the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests Office and inform this Ministry on a most immediate basis the exact position, namely (a) Whether the officer has become a member of the scheme initially u.e.f. 1.1.1982 or in fact opted out of the or (b) whether he has utilised the opportunity made available to him

Scheme

under the scheme to become a member w.e.f. 1.1.1987.

3. Unless confirmation from the State Government of Assam with regard to the authenticity of the membership of the Retired Officer Shri S. Deb Roy under the Central Government Employees Insurance Scheme is established and confirmed, it is not possible for this Ministry to examine the question of release / or refunds of subscriptions to the retired officer.

4. You are also requested to send formal proposals in Annexure-III (Part -II of Annexure-III duly filled by the designated officer of the State Government) together with a certificate to the effect that necessary deductions from the officer towards the scheme from the date of enrolment to the date of his Central deputation, i.e. upto April, 1990, have been made.

5. As the officer is pressing hard for early action in the matter, State Forest Department may kindly ensure immediately action in the matter.

5. The period of which a subscription to a Fund is due should be specified when it differs from the period for which pay is drawn.

Note :- 1. Treasury and Audit Officers should see that all compulsory deductions are duly made and that schedules regarding G.P. Fund etc. when such schedules prepared by the Officers themselves are attached to the pay bills.



Dear Madam,
I hope this will find you in the very best of everything with Mr. Trivedi. kindly excuse my delay in replying your letter, which I had received sometime back. There are a host of reasons but the main is that I have been thoroughly demoralised in Assam. You will be surprised that I am now trying to find an opening to go to Delhi.

A post of Principal C.C.F. with a fixed scale of pay at Rs 7,600/- p. month has been created by converting the post of the C.C.F. Assam in Assam. The political bosses want to promote Neog to this post, but he is facing Criminal procedure, suggested by the sp. vigilance cell. There are another 50 officers of the Deptt who are facing similar charges. Neog had been reinstated, all the same in July, but Mr. Phem has blocked his selection as the Principal C.C.F. on legal grounds and probably wants me to be selected.

Naturally there is a lot of opposition from the sons of the soil, who are working in our department. Such people have rallied behind Neog and have been flashing various rumours against me. The students are however, siding with me in general, which seems to be ^{needing} ^{me} ^{as} ^{the} ^{C.C.F.} ^(a) ^{despite} ^{C.M.'s} ^{wishes} ^{of} ^a ^{different} ^{standing}. I am not interested in such bickering and want to hang on to my wildlife. I have made myself emphatically clear about this to all, but even so a lot of slurr has been deliberately thrown at me, probably to level me down with the others, who are corrupt. Sri K.K. Barua has also been reinstated last week. Now both Neog and Barua have been O.S.Ds, without any work or sanction of posts.

All this has depressed me terribly

I have applied to go for a deputatⁿ in
to Govt. of India. I had talked & written
to Dr. M. S. Swaminathan about my intentions
and he has assured me of help. He has
probably put in a word with Sri Acethakrishnan,
who is now the Secy. Environment. I am still
left with 3 years and 9 months of service &
so if I get any suitable opening, I may
shift to Delhi permanently.

I had never imagined, I may have to
face such a situation and naturally got
terribly upset. The forests are dwindling much
faster than you can imagine, about which I
feel sad and guilty as a professional forester.
The entire north belt from Sankosh to N. Lakhimpur
is under siege by the Bodo people and jungles
are being cleared ruthlessly, while there is
hardly any administration. There is total chaos.
The future appears to me to be complete
black. 15-20 years from now living in Assam
may become a nightmare. The wildlife sphere is
much better in comparison, but even there bad signs
are casting shadows. Dishonesty has become the
order of the day. It was good that you could
leave in time and in colours.

My elder son will appear at P.U. science
this year and ^{the} younger one got to class IV. Manjre
is well. I had an attack of mild pneumonia, but
now I am alright. If not inconvenient, kindly
send a check to Sri Salandil Sharma of Kokrajhar,
who had sent you the timber.

If you had been in the Dept. of Personnel
now, may be you could have helped me now.
But let me see, what is in store for me. I am
sure God will be by my side. With all the
respect and regards to both of you, Yours sincerely
