My dear Dr Krishnan,

I am sorry for delaying this letter to you but I have been investigating the possibility of getting your camera here; it is too expensive.

The prices in Gt Britain are prohibitive and the delay of obtaining one without paying any duty is too long, about one month.

I have inquired with the agents of Paillard in London and they state that

1) Single lens 8mm £ 37-10-0
(without duty)

2) Twin lens. (36 mm telephoto
F1.9 ordinary)

£ 78/-

If bought in Gt Britain we have to pay a duty of about 100% on this value and if we order it to be delivered at the airplane or ship then the above prices hold. They however said that it would take about a month to complete formalities.

I have asked them to let me know whether I could pay in £ sterling in London and pick up the camera at say Zurich or Geneva air port and they have promised to let me know their answer on my return to London.

Please let me have your instructions at London where I expect to be about the 12th Oct. I shall call on Dr Krishna of the High Commission so that you
