





Dear Dr. Bahadur,

I write in reply to your letter of the 2nd December concerning your previous letter asking for financial support from the International Union of Biochemistry in connection with your visit to Moscow next year to take part in the Symposium on the Origin of Life. I have recently visited Moscow to discuss arrangements for this Symposium with the organizers, and have also had correspondence with Professor Florkin and Professor Stotz about this matter. 

In this connection please note that we have a bi-weekly service from Delhi to Kabul which leaves every Tuesdays and Saturdays from Safdarjung airport at 0730 hrs. arriving Kabul at 1335 hrs. M/S. 

Passengers should also be in possession of income-tax clearance and or exemption certificate before they leave India and this certificate is to be surrendered to the initial carrier before any ticket is issued.

My dear Dr. Bahadur,

I am in receipt of your kind letter dated 15.6.1957 and I take this opportunity of expressing my heartiest congratulations for the honour conferred on you. I have no doubt that you deserve more than this. I am sure our country will benefit by your participation in the symposium.

As regards the preparation of a passport I am to inform you that passports for countries other than Pakistan are issued by the Regional Passport Officer, Lucknow, which is an office of the Government of India. In the first instance you have to apply to the District Magistrate in a prescribed form available from his office with a fee of Rs. 10/-. The District Magistrate sends his recommendation to the Regional Passport Officer after satisfying himself the formalities required in the application form and the genuineness of the purpose of the visit. I would suggest that you may kindly fill in the form and supply other information to the District Magistrate as early as possible because sometimes it does take some time in the issue of passports. After the District Magistrate sends your application to the Regional Passport Officer, you may drop me a line and I shall request the officer concerned to expedite the matter.

We have for acknowledgment your letter dated 16 June 1957.

We are pleased to advise that we have five flights a week to Rome from Karachi leaving on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays with immediate connections to Vienna and thence on to Moscow. Convenient connections are available between Delhi and Karachi either by Indian Airlines or by Pakistan International Airlines.

Our round trip tourist fare to Moscow, London and return is Rs. 4893.00 and by first class is Rs. 6446.00. These fares will permit you to visit both Paris and Rome. Children under 2 years of age are charged 10% of the adult fare and children between the ages of 2 and 11 are charged 50% of the fare.

The free baggage allowance is 44 lbs. and 66 lbs. per passenger for tourist and first class passengers respectively. 50% fare paying passengers are also entitled to the same free baggage allowances. However, no free baggage allowance is allowed to 10% fare paying passengers.

You should be in possession of valid passports duly endorsed and visaed for the countries you propose to visit. However, no visa is required for the United Kingdom but the passport should be endorsed for this country.

You should obtain certificates of vaccination against smallpox dated not less than 8 days nor more than 3 years and inoculation against cholera dated not less than 6 days nor more than 6 months.

In accordance with the Indian Incometax Regulations all passengers above the age of 18 should be in possession of incometax clearance or exemption certificate as the case may be. This certificate is issued by the Foreign Section of the Incometax Department presently located in the Central Revenue Buildings, Mathura Road, New Delhi, on production of Form A from the local District Incometax Officer.

Dear Sir,

The Embassy is pleased to inform you that the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany has further liberalized its entry regulations. With effect of May 15th, 1956, holders of valid Indian passports do not require a visa for entering Germany, provided they are not committed to any profession for gain or to any other kind of employment in Germany. That means that Indian students and tourists, irrespective of the duration of their stay in Germany, may proceed there without having obtained a visa.

However, practical trainees, apprentices and all persons who intend to take up employment in Germany, still require an entry-visa which may be applied for at the:


With the application for the issue of a visa a so-called "Permit of Residence" to be obtained beforehand from the municipality (Ausländerpolizeiabteilung) of the intended place of stay in Germany has to be presented. The factory to be joined will certainly be willing to help in obtaining this permit.

While applying for the visa to the above mentioned office the following documents have to be presented:

- 1) valid Indian passport,
- 2) the Permit of Residence as mentioned above,
- 3) visa application form duly filled in,
- 4) a visa fee of Rs 9/8 for a single and Rs 19/- for a multiple entry visa.

NOTES FOR THE GUIDANCE OF APPLICANTS FOR INDIAN PASSPORTS

(To be retained by the applicant)

Regional Offices for the issue of Indian passports are located at the following places in India :—

<i>Headquarters</i>	<i>States served</i>
1. MADRAS	Madras, Andhra, Mysore, Travancore-Cochin, Coorg and Pondicherry.
2. BOMBAY	Bombay, Cutch and Saurashtra.
3. DELHI	Delhi, Punjab, Uttar Pradesh, PEPSU, Kashmir, Rajasthan, Himachal Pradesh and Ajmer.
4. CALCUTTA	West Bengal, Bihar, Orissa, Assam, Tripura and Manipur.
5. NAGPUR	Madhya Pradesh, Vindhya Pradesh, Madhya Bharat, Hyderabad and Bhopal.

An applicant for an Indian passport should complete the prescribed application form in duplicate and present it personally or send it by registered post, to the District Magistrate/Deputy Commissioner/Collector/Commissioner of Police, within whose jurisdiction he or she usually resides.

N. B.—Care should be taken to see that the application is complete in every detail, as incomplete information is likely to involve return of the application form to the applicant and consequent delay in the disposal of the application.

Application forms are obtainable from District Magistrates/Deputy Commissioners/Collectors/Commissioners of Police/Regional Passport Officers.

A passport is normally available in the first instance, for five years from the date of issue, but the Issuing Authority has the discretion to validate it for a lesser period.

The fee for the issue of an Indian passport is Rs. 10/- which should be remitted by Money Order direct to the Regional Passport Officer concerned, stating in the coupon the authority to whom the application has been submitted. The post office receipt should be attached to the original copy of the application.

The validity of an Indian passport may be extended from time to time, up to a maximum period of ten years from the date of its issue, on application being made in the prescribed form to the Regional Passport Officer concerned, together with the requisite fee, not earlier than three months before the expiry, and not later than one month after the expiry, of the previous validity. After a period of ten years from the date of issue, a new passport must be obtained.

A passport whose validity has been restricted to less than five years at the time of issue will be renewed up to the normal period of five years, free of charge. Thereafter a fee of Rs. 2/- will be charged for each year, or portion of a year, for which renewal is required.

A child under 15 years of age will ordinarily be required to have its name included in the passport of either parent or of the guardian with whom it is travelling. A child whose name is included in a parent's or guardian's passport, will not be able to travel independently of the parent or guardian on such a passport.

In the case of a child under 18 years of age requiring a separate passport, the child's parent or legal guardian should make an application on the special application form prescribed for this purpose.

An application for a passport must be accompanied by three unmounted bust photographs (size approximately $2\frac{3}{4}'' \times 2''$) of the applicant (and of his wife if she is to be included in the passport) taken full face against a light background. Photographs are not required of children below 15 years of age whose names are to be included in the passport of a parent or guardian.

Purdah-nashin or Gosha women travelling to Malaya, Uganda, Tanganyika, Mauritius, Zanzibar, Nyasaland Protectorate, the Union of South Africa, Syria, Palestine, Iraq, Egypt, Saudi Arabia, Trans-Jordan, Iran, the Persian Gulf Ports, Aden, Burma, Afghanistan and Pakistan, are exempted from the necessity of attaching copies of their photographs to their applications. The exemption is applicable in the case of Egypt and Pakistan only, if the applicants are accompanied by their husbands or any of their relatives who accept legal responsibility for them.

A passport is only available for travel to the countries for which it has been endorsed. If it is found at any time that the holder had travelled to a country for which no endorsement had been granted on the passport, the passport is liable to cancellation.

Additional endorsements may be obtained at any time during the period of validity of a passport on a written application, giving reasons for the necessity of the additional endorsements, being made to the Regional Passport Office concerned.

The fee for each additional endorsement, and for other miscellaneous services, is Re. 1.

Passport fees will under no circumstances be refunded.

The possession of an Indian passport does not exempt the holder from compliance with any Immigration Laws in force in another country or from the necessity of obtaining a visa or entry permit where required. Prospective travellers are strongly advised to contact a reputable Travel Agency or the Representatives in India of the countries which they intend visiting or passing through.

A passport should, under no circumstances, be sent out of the country of residence by post.

Holders of Indian passports are warned that additions or alterations made in their passports unauthorisedly may result in the cancellation of their passports. Additions and alterations can only be made by a Regional Passport Office in India or an Indian Diplomatic or Consular Representative abroad.


It is most important that Indian citizens while abroad, should get in touch with the nearest Indian Representative. Changes of address and departures from the country, should also be notified to them. Failure to do so may, in a time of emergency, result in difficulty in Indian citizens being accorded the assistance and protection to which they are entitled.

An Indian citizen residing abroad and who desires any passport facility should contact the nearest Indian diplomatic or Consular Representative.
