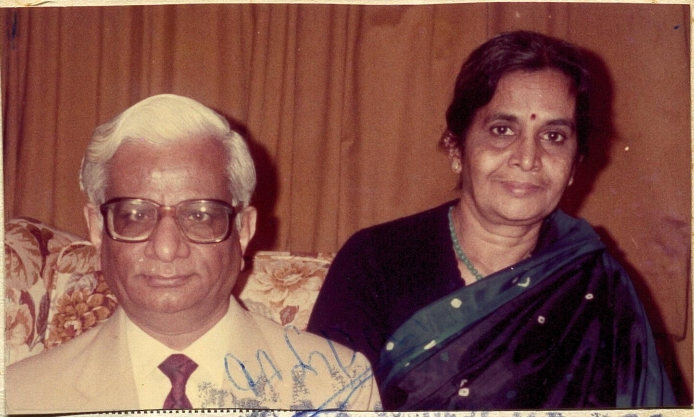

Note (1).—No pension shall be liable to seizure, attachment or sequestration by process of any Court in India at the instance of creditor for any demand against the Pensioner (Section II, Act XXIII of 1871).

Note (2).—Payment under this order is to be made only to the Pensioner in person with the following exceptions:—

**A Declaration regarding Non Receipt of a Criminal Proceedings should be obtained before that payment.**
- (a) To persons specially exempted by Government.

a Class I Officer of the Reserve Bank of India or an Officer including Officer Grade II of the State Bank of India or an Officer of a subsidiary bank of the State Bank of India, or by the Head of a Village Panchayat, Gram Panchayat or Gaon Panchayat, or by the Head of an Executive Committee of a village or by a Bank included in the second schedule to the Reserve Bank of India Act, 1934, in respect of pensioner drawing pension through that Bank.

- (d) To any person resident in India who draws his pension through an agent who has executed a bond to refund overpayments subject to the condition that the latter produces at least once a year a Life Certificate by a person mentioned in Clause (c).
- (e) In all cases referred to in clauses (a), (b) & (c) the Disbursing Officer must at least once a year require proof independent of that furnished by the life certificate, of the continued existence of the pensioner. In cases referred to in clause (d), the pension shall not be paid on account of a period more than a year after the date of life certificate last received, and the Disbursing Officer must be on the watch for authentic information of the decease of any such pensioner and on receipt thereof, shall promptly stop further payment.

*Note (3).*—On the decease of the pensioner this order should be immediately returned by his family to the Pension Disbursing Officer with a report of the date of his decease, if the Family Pension 1964, is not admissible to the widow/widower.

In the event of the death of a Pensioner governed by the C.C.S. (P) Rules within a period of five years from the date of retirement, the following benefits are admissible under certain circumstances:—

- (a) Grant of family pension to the person mentioned in Rule 54, and
- (b) Payment of a residuary gratuity under Rule 50 (2) *ibid*, to the nominee, or in cases where there is no nomination or where the nominations made do not subsist, to the legal heir of the deceased.

Formal claims for these benefits, duly supported by legal authority, where necessary, should be submitted to the Head of the Office/Department.




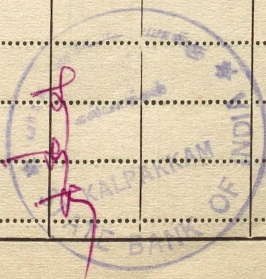
