Doordarshan has covered two pictures of inaugural address and exhibition in local news on 20th June. I am attaching herewith a press slip and photograph for your information.

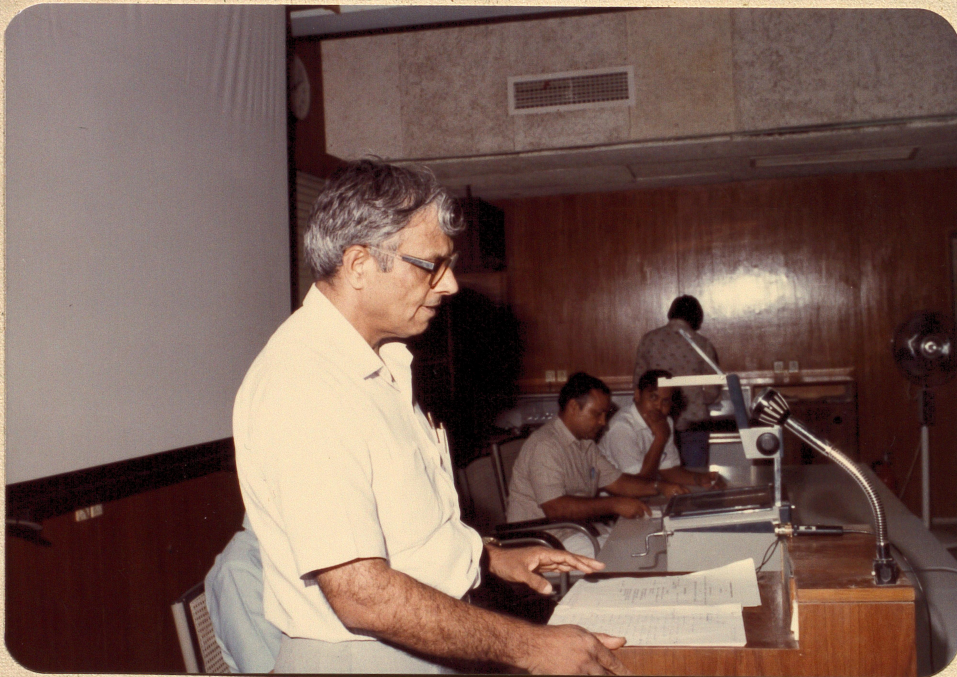

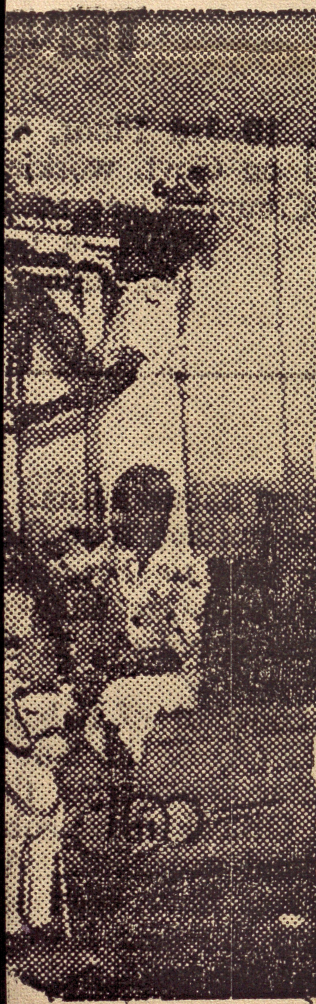

Focus on transfer of know-how

AHMEDABAD, June 19: A seminar-cum-exhibition for the benefit of prospective entrepreneurs, particularly from research and academic institutions such as SAC, PRL, ATIRA, NID, departments of Gujarat university and L. D. engineering college, was organised today at the PRL, jointly by Small Industries Service Institute (SISI) and AAPP, western centre of department of electronics.

Inaugurating the seminar, Prof. R. K. Varma, PRL, director, commended this idea of discussing aspects of transfer of know-how from scientists to the industry.

It emerged that a wide range of developments could help small-scale production. They ranged from simple mechanical devices to full-fledged machines and plants, as well as from chemical formulations to sophisticated electronic systems required for satellite applications.
