Sir,

With due respect, I beg to approach you with the following few lines for your sympathetic consideration.

I am a IIIrd Division Clerk, attached to the Purchase Section. For sometime, I have been finding difficulty in making both ends meet with my present salary, as this place is a most expensive one. I am a family man, having wife and children, and they are living at Delhi in one of the Government allotted refugee quarters. I have not been given any quarters here, and I am occupying a seat in a mess. Thus, I have to keep two establishments. First, I have to maintain myself here, and secondly I have to take care of my family men who are residing at Delhi. It has therefore become extremely difficult for me to maintain myself and my family.

Further, I am a refugee from West Pakistan. I have been provided with a Government Quarter for refugees at Delhi. My family is living in this quarter. I understand that if I bring my family here, Government will not allow me to retain this quarter there. As this quarter was given to me free, as a refugee, I think I ought to retain it at any cost. Otherwise, I will lose shelter.

In the circumstances, I presume that it would redress my difficulties if I am kindly be transferred to any one of the C.S.I.R. Laboratories at Delhi. Hence I am approaching you with the request that you would kindly arrange for my transfer to any of the Laboratories nearer to Delhi i.e. N.P.L. or C.R.R.I. I would be much grateful to you as this will help me in my present pitiable condition.
