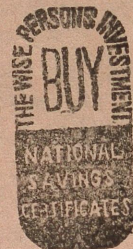

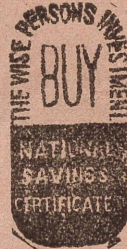

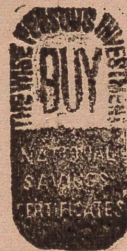

It is also my prayer, that you should live for many years to come, in good health, so that our country may benefit, in its status of learning moral strength and scientific progress by your invaluable guidance.


