

Minutes of the meeting with Dr. J.P. Pascal on 4th. Sept. 1991

1. The whole of the Nilgiri Biosphere Region map should be published including the Karnataka and North Kerala portions in course of time; over about two years.

2. The Nilgiri Biosphere map will be in four pieces with legend and insets to depict the bio-climatic features of the area, topography, drainage, eco-floristic zones, etc. The map will be supplemented with an explanatory booklet.

3. The map will be jointly published by the French Institute and the Indian Institute of Science.

4. For the thesis and for the immediate study and analysis, Mr. Prabhakar would interpret the southern portions of the Biosphere Reserve and keep ready the master copy of the final vegetation map.

5. Mr. Petrus will start work on the middle and southern three sheets, and use the topo sheets to reduce and draw the final sheets for the roads, cadastral lines (RF, division, taluk, district and state). These will be drawn and kept ready as to print. It may take about four months for completion and would be ready for use in the thesis. The French Institute will provide a copy of the overlay of each sheet in transparent paper that could be directly used in analysis.

6. The master copy of the satellite interpretation of the vegetation will be redrawn by Mr. Petrus, ammonia copies made and one coloured copy available for thesis work and analysis.

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
