Wynad, the hilly district of Kerala, populated mostly by the tribes, is situated at an altitude of 712 metres above sea level in the eastern borders of Kerala, adjacent to the Western Ghats. The District is very famous for the production of Coffee, Tea and Spices like Ginger, Cardamom and Pepper. Until very recently, a place in Wynad was very famous as it was second to Chirapunji in rainfall in the whole world. Consequently the economy of Kerala as well as of the Nation was deeply influenced by the cash products of Wynad since it was earning a considerable amount of foreign exchange. This beautiful place with all its peculiarities is now facing a great danger since the ecological balance of the area is totally destroyed due to the deforestation carried out by the Government as well as by other agencies. This has been carried out in Wynad for the last one decade overcoming all the Statutes of the Centre and State Governments. It has ultimately resulted in the deplorable condition resulting in the various problems like the wide spread crop failure, draught, scarcity of water, etc. The request and demands of the people of Wynad for the Preservation of Forests in Wynad was either cruelly neglected or uncared by the Governments. The Government has not even taken any effective step to prevent the deforestation carried out by the unscrupulous antisocial elements. Hence the people of Wynad was forced to form a society entitled "THE WYNAD NATURE PRESERVATION COMMITTEE" to fight against the deforestation and to maintain the ecological balance of the area. Hence we submit the following resolution passed by the above said Committee for immediate and favourable action.

5) A programme of Scientific forestry may be launched and implemented in Wynad immediately.

6) The plantation of Eucalyptus which has adversely affected the ecology of Wynad may be immediately stopped and in its place, steps may be taken, to plant other trees of different ^{etc} species, which will form a "thick forest".
