

Professor B. V. Sreekantan

B. V. Sreekantan is presently (Hon ) Visiting Professor at the National Institute of Advanced Studies Bangalore. After obtaining M.Sc. degree in Physics from the University of Mysore, he joined the Tata Institute of Fundamental Research, Bombay and obtained his Ph.D from the Bombay University In 1954. Over a period of 44 years at the TIFR, he carried out experimental research in Cosmic Rays, High Energy Physics, and High Energy Astronomies and published over 200 papers. He was Director of the TIFR during 1975-87 and Indian National Academy Srinivasa Ramanujan Professor during 87-92. He was Visiting Scientist/Visiting Professor at several universities in the US and Japan.

He joined the National Institute of Advanced Studies in 1992 as Dr. Radhakrishnan Visiting Professor and was Senior Homi Bhabha Fellow during 95-97.

His current interests are in the field of Philosophy Of Science, in particular on Scientific and Philosophical Studies on Consciousness.

He is a Fellow of the Indian Academy of Sciences, of the Indian National Academy of Science and of the National Academy of Science. He has received many professional awards . He is a recipient of Padma Bhushan Award by Rastrapathi, , the Rajyotsava Award by the Karnataka Government and the Jawaharlal Nehru National Award by the MP Government. In 2003 he was awarded the Yodh Prize Of the Cosmic Ray Commission of IUPAP and the University of California, Irwine for his lifetime contributions to Cosmic Ray Research.
