

7. Publication of a Field Guide to the Birds of Kerala

Background

No exhaustive Field Guide has been published on the birds of Kerala so far. The books available on the birds of Kerala are published by Dr. Salim Ali (Birds of Kerala) and the classical Malayalam book by K.K. Neelakantan (Keralathilae Pakshikal). An addition to the Birds of Kerala was published by Sasikumar *et al.* (1993) including the newly discovered bird species from Kerala. Recently a book on the Waders of Kerala was published by Sasikumar *et al.* (2005). Even though much data is available on the birds of Kerala, no exclusive field guide is available on the birds of Kerala. The proposed Field Guide will be highly useful to the bird watchers, students, naturalists, conservationists and to the scientific community. Tourists also will be interested in the Field Guide. It is proposal is to publish a Field Guide on the birds of Kerala with around 250 printed pages and 80 colour plates depicting the important bird species of Kerala State.

Objectives

The broad objective is to prepare a field guide to the birds of Kerala State. Specific objectives of the study are given below.

1. To collect available information on the birds of Kerala.
2. To prepare a Field Guide to the birds of Kerala.
3. To print and publish a Field Guide on the Birds of Kerala.

Methodology

Available data on the birds of Kerala will be collected from literature and reprints. A Field Guide to the birds of Kerala will be prepared based on the data. Figures of the birds will be drawn by a professional wildlife artist based on observations and photographs captured from the field. It is proposed to print thousand copies of the field Guide with colour plates. Mr. Carl D Sylva, Goa, a professional artist who has drawn pictures for famous Field Guides on birds, including the "Book of Indian Birds" by Dr. Salim Ali has agreed to participate in the project.

Expected Output

The present study will produce a detailed Field Guide on the birds of Kerala. The Field Guide will be highly useful to ornithologists, naturalists, students and amateur bird watchers. The Field Guide will be helpful to all people who are interested in the conservation of nature. Tourists coming to the State also will be interested. Conservation agencies will be able to utilise the data derived from the study namely, the Kerala Forest and Wildlife Dept. and Central Govt. Departments.
