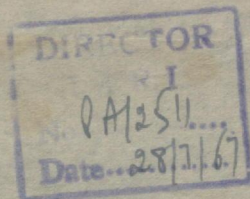

Dear Sir,

I have been regularly growing on our Farm 'N.P.710', 'N.P.824' and 'Sonora-64' varieties of wheat under irrigation in the winter season since 1964. You were kind enough to allow me to have a varietal trial of wheat through your Research Station in Nilgiris in the year 1965, wherein the above varieties showed good results. I have been harvesting not less than 15 quintals of wheat per acre every year. I have also distributed the seed of the above mentioned varieties to the farmers of my neighbourhood, who are now taking as a regular Rabi crop.

In the June Issue of Indian Farming, I recently read a note about the new 'Sharabati-1 Sonora-64' varieties wheat developed by you having bold ambar grains which has been multiplied in the Nilgiris and approved for general cultivation. I request you to kindly supply me the seed of this variety for one acre to be sown in the coming Rabi season. I shall multiply this variety and also distribute the seed, thus multiplied, to the farmers of my neighbourhood. I am again ready to have as varietal trial for your newly discovered high yielding varieties of wheat if you kindly allow me to do so. I shall be extremely thankful, if you also kindly send me the literature connected with 'Sharabati Sonora-64'. I very much wish that you should visit our Farm whenever you come on tour in the South, to advise and guide me in my work. Our Farm is situated on the 7th mile on Bangalore-Magadi Road.
