INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTER DISPLAYS AT THE 3RD ICEM

1. DATE FOR EXHIBITION

Poster displays will be on exhibit all day on both September 22, Tuesday and September 23, Wednesday. Each poster display will be exhibited on only one of these dates. The number for each display will be listed in the program which will be mailed to participants in August, and it will be also indicated at the display area.

2. DAILY EXHIBITION HOURS

The poster display area will be open on both days from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Authors are requested to prepare their displays between 9:00 and 10:00 a.m. and to remove them between 3:30 and 4:00 p.m. They are also requested to be present and available for questions at their respective display sites from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

3. THE LANGUAGE TO BE USED IN POSTER DISPLAY, as throughout the conference, is English.

4. CONFERENCE PROVISIONS FOR POSTER DISPLAYS

We will provide each author with a plywood board, measuring 1.5 meters x 1.5 meters, onto which he or she can attach materials with thumbtacks.

5. LAYOUT REQUIREMENT FOR DISPLAYS

The title of the display, along with author's name and affiliation should be clearly written across the top of the display board.
