Dear Dr. Varma:

I wish to express to you our sincere gratitude for your informal consent to join our faculty as a visiting professor. Now, I would be happy to invite you officially to our University, under the following conditions upon which our contract is to be signed. Would you read them carefully and tell me if they are satisfactory at your earliest convenience.

1. Department: Institute for Fusion Theory, Hiroshima University
2. Duties: Research collaboration with staff members of the Institute for Fusion Theory;  
Research guidance of undergraduate and graduate students of the Faculty of Science;  
Lectures, discussions and research guidance at seminars and meetings.
3. Term of Appointment: 6 months, from April 1, 1980, to September 30, 1980.
4. Monthly Allowance: 557,000 yen (monthly allowance) shall be paid on the fixed day, every month.
5. Residence: Throughout the aforementioned term of appointment, you shall be provided with an residence with furniture, electricity, gas and city water. you will have to pay a monthly rent (about 10,000 yen) and monthly charges for electricity, gas and city water to the University.



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6. Travel Expenses: (1) The expense for travelling from your present address to the University via usual route, including the first class air fare, train fare, daily allowances, hotel charges, fees for vaccination, passport and visa application and foreign currency exchange, and your entry custom shall be reimbursed to you in yen upon your arrival at the University. However, in case you are paid the fees for vaccination, passport and visa application and foreign currency exchange, and your entry custom, you will have to submit the certificates of your payment. (2) Your return travel expenses shall be likewise paid to you in yen at the time of your departure from the University upon and only upon the case that you have the term of office for six months and over.

If you consider these conditions satisfactory, please send us the following informations at your earliest convenience.

1. Your address at the time of your departure for Japan;
2. An itemized estimate of your travel expenses (at every means of transportation) from your home town to Japan, the fees for vaccination, passport and visa application and foreign currency exchange, and your entry custom;
3. The name of your airlines (We want you to use Japan Air Lines, as much as possible.);
4. The starting and arrival times of your plane.
