Dear Dr. Krishnan,

With a view to improving the programmes of All India Radio and ensuring that they attain and maintain a high standard, I have been thinking of ways and means of getting the help and cooperation of competent persons whose knowledge and experience would guide and facilitate improvement in A.I.R. With this object in view it has been decided to set up a Central Programme Advisory Committee, membership of which I am requesting you kindly to accept.

The Central Programme Advisory Committee will meet once or twice a year and will lay down the general policy regarding programmes and in that light examine programmes of various stations. It will also lay down lines for future planning of programmes. I am sure you will agree that a systematic study of the programme policy will be of great benefit to A.I.R. As soon as intimation of your acceptance is received, fuller information about the procedure etc. will be sent to you.
