MEDICAL SCHEME:

All members of the Tata Institute of Fundamental Research including the peons, canteen and garden staff requiring medical treatment will report to the Honorary Medical Officer, Dr. R.H.Dastur, at Mherwan Building, Sir Phirozeshah Mehta Road, Fort, Bombay, between the hours 10-45 a.m. to 12-15 p.m.

All employees are entitled to free routine medicines, injections, etc. They will also be entitled to free injections and vaccination at the time of epidemics.

If a patient requires the doctor to visit him, it will be on a payment, to be borne by the patient, of Rs.5/- per visit at the Hostel and Rs.10/- per visit in the area extending from Colaba to Dadar.

This scheme comes into force from June 1st, 1950.

Scholarship Rules.

1. Award - Scholarships shall normally be awarded by the Director on the recommendation of the Common Room, and shall not extend beyond the end of the current academic year.
2. Renewal - A scholarship may be renewed at the end of an academic year on the recommendation of the Professor or Reader. A scholarship shall be tenable normally for 2 years.
3. Continuation - A scholarship may be discontinued at any time if the scholar's work is found to be unsatisfactory by the Professor or Reader.
4. Report - Each scholar shall submit a periodical report every year on the work done by him.
5. Observance of rules - Non-observance of rules or an adverse report from the Professor or Reader under whom the student is working may lead to the immediate stoppage of the scholarship.
6. Gross misconduct - If a scholar is dismissed for gross misconduct or insubordination, he shall refund the amount in full or in part, as the Council may direct, of the scholarship he has received.
7. Refund - If a scholar leaves the Institute with his work unfinished, he shall be liable to refund the amount of the scholarship unless he completes the work within a reasonable period fixed by the Director.
8. Agreement - Each scholar shall be supplied with a copy of these rules and he shall agree, in writing, to abide by them.


