You may remember the talk we had about a popular science journal in Tamil. I wrote to S. C. Rajagopalachari about it. He has written to say that he likes the idea very much. But he thinks that in the beginning, it should be in the nature of separate books so that we may not be bound by too stringent a specified date. He has undertaken to find publishers and I think he will readily consent to become the general Editor of the series. The series may be called *Bangana* and each <sup>issue of the</sup> series may consist of five or six articles on different scientific topics. While each article should be

to be out by the end of that month.
