



Ref:- Your letter No. F.7/28083 dated 18th Sept. 1954


Sir,

Dr. M.S. Swaminathan accepts the offer on the terms and conditions mentioned in your letter referred to above and he will be relieved here so that he may join the post at I.A.R.I. on the 4th October, 1954.

With regard to verification of character and antecedents, I presumed that it was not necessary in as much as he was offered an appointment in the Indian Police Service on 2nd Dec. 1949. The Home Ministry, Govt. of India, I expect, would have made sufficient enquiries regarding this before the issue of the order of appointment in the I.P.S. Since 1949 he has been living abroad and returned to India only in January 1954.

So far he has not been examined by the Medical Board during the appointment in this Institute.

A CLASS II POSTS OF ASSISTANT CYTOGENETICIST.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your D.O. letter No.15907 dated 26.8.54, on the above subject and to convey the approval of the President to the appointment of Dr. M.S. Swaminathan to the Class II post of Assistant Cytogeneticist, in the scale of Rs. 275-25-500-E.B.-30-800, at the Indian Agricultural Research Institute, pending selection by the Union Public Service Commission.

2. Sanction of the President is also accorded to the grant of an higher initial pay of Rs. 450/- (Rupees four hundred and fifty only) to Dr. Swaminathan, in the aforesaid scale. The other terms and conditions of his service would be the same as an applicable to the Government Servants of his status.
