Kindly refer to Dr N V Joshi's letter dated November 2, 1992.

As you are aware, the three year project entitled "Long Term Collaboration with the Centre for Ecological Sciences (CES), Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore, for Multivariate Statistical Analysis of Data generated under the People of India Project" has been approved by the Department of Culture. This project, undertaken in the Seventh Five Year Plan, is now considered to be a continuation of the People of India Project in the Eighth Five Year Plan under the scheme "People of India Project : Second Phase". This will have the following components :

- a) Collaboration with the Centre for Ecological Sciences, Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore, in long term multivariate analysis of the data;
- b) Collaboration with the Place Names Society of India in compiling a national dictionary of Place Names and Personal Names;
- c) Community-wise analysis of anthropometric data already collected, and extension of an anthropometric survey to the remaining parts of the country;
- d) Community-wise analysis of the data generated by the bio-anthropological survey and the data feeding of the raw data;
- e) Analysis of micro-level (within a state) data on other dimensions of biological variations of the Indian populations, collected from secondary sources;
- f) Further analysis of the segments of communities within a state/union territory and upto the district level.

Item (a) directly relates to the Centre for Ecological Sciences.

Your attention is drawn to the last para of the original proposal on coordination/personnel who will be associated with the project from both the Anthropological Survey of India and the Centre for Ecological Sciences.

Dr Niranjan Joshi, CES, Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore and Shri Suresh Patil, Anthropological Survey of India, Southern Regional Centre, Mysore, will be the two Principa Co-Investigators for this project. The An.S.I, Mysore Centre will provide funds and all other facilities and coordinate with CES. Dr K S Singh, Director General, An.S.I. and Prof Madhav Gadgil, Centre for Ecological Sciences, Indian Insititute of Science, will provide overall guidance for the conduct of the project. In addition, Dr Anil Gore, Deptt. of Statistics, Poona University, Prof K C Malhotra, Division of Biological Sciences, Indian Statistical Institute, Calcutta, and other scholars will be consulted while analysing and interpreting the data. As CES will also be contributing its own data, An.S.I. and CES will jointly organize, edit and publish the material.

The corresponding level of coordination from the An.S.I will be as follows :

Principa Investigator - Suresh Patil

Principal Co-Investigator/Supervisor - Dr K S Singh,
Director General
An.S.I.

Shri S Patil will be involved as Coordinator after March, 1993 when he completes his present assignment. He will be employed full time on this project on behalf of the An.S.I, Southern Regional Centre, Mysore.

The books based on the analysis of the An.S.I. data will carry a common foreward like the other works brought out by the Anthropological Survey of India under the People of India Project. The findings will also be discussed with the scholars of the An.S.I. who have been involved in this Project and with scholars from outside.

All works shall be jointly edited by the Principa Investigator/Co-Investigator of the two organizations and published jointly by the two organizations.

The Head Office of the An.S.I. will release a sum of Rs.4 lakhs to the Southern Regional Centre, Mysore, for disbursement to the Centre for Ecological Science through the Registrar, Indian Institute of Sciences, Bangalore. The amount has been released to the Mysore office today.
