RESTORATION ECOLOGY AND REJUVENATION OF DEGRADED ECOSYSTEMS

An Year-round Programme

Round One : Restoration of Degraded Mountain Slopes, Grasslands, and Savannah Landscapes.

Location: Near Panshet Dam

Duration: 4 days camp at Panshet followed by 15 days of classroom and computer work in evening in Pune. June

Cost: Rs. 1200 per student

Round Two : Restoration of Forest

Location: Bhandardara/Kalsubai forest area.

Duration: 4 days camp at Bhandaradara followed by 15 days of classroom and computer work in the evening in Pune in October/November

Cost: Rs. 1200 per student

Round Three : Restoration of Wetlands, Streams and Rivers.

Location: Varna dam west of Karad

Duration: 5 days camp at Varnavati followed by 10 days of classroom and computer work in the evening in Pune in December/January

Cost: Rs. 1200 per student

Round Four : Restoration of Estuaries and Marine Habitats

Location: Near Dapoli

Duration: 4 days of camp near Dapoli followed by 10 days of classroom and computer work in the evening in Pune in February/March

Cost: Rs. 1200 per student

Enrolment : Students can enrol for any one or all the rounds of the programme. For round one the last date of enrolment is 31st May 1996.

An evening orientation course will be organized in May 1996 if 10 or more candidates enrol before 31st May 1996. The details of the orientation course will be given at the time of enrolment.
