This 3-month course is offered annually, and applications are invited for 1990.

The content of the programme, which is highly selective, is presented under the following headings:-

- Agriculture
- Women and Development
- Food, Nutrition and Health
- Extension, Education and Training
- Study, Recording and Communication Skills

The course work is integrated with practical projects and workshops. In this way, it is intended that participants should gain knowledge, perspectives and skills which are directly applicable to their current work, as well as generally supportive of their ongoing professional education.

The course is intended to meet the training needs of women development staff engaged in working with rural women in the field, and those in administrative posts concerned with women's affairs for which there may as yet be no specific training available.

The course is especially suitable for non-graduates, though some formal qualifications will be assumed. Relevant work experience, responsibilities and training needs will be the main criteria for admission.

Tuition fees are estimated at £1,600\* and accommodation with full board in one of the Halls of Residence at £450\*.


