My dear Dr Krishnan:

Thank you for your letter of the 15th of November. I have sent you a telegram saying that 16th December will suit us best. 22nd or 23rd will be a little too early for the various arrangements that have to be made. I hope that 16th will be convenient to you. You could leave Delhi on Thursday, the 15th afternoon by the Deluxe train at 4 p.m. and arrive at Baroda at 9-30 a.m. the next day. I shall meet you at the station and bring you down here which is only 30 miles from Baroda. If you have time to spare, you could again take the same Deluxe train from Baroda on the 18th afternoon at 5 p.m. It will take you to Delhi at 10-30 a.m. on the 19th. You will thus be able to spend with us here 16th, 17th and half of 18th. If you cannot spare that much time then you could return either by air or by Frontier Mail on the 16th-17th midnight or 17-18th midnight as suits you best.

If you are able to leave Delhi a day earlier by the Frontier Mail on the 14th you would arrive at Baroda on the 15th at 3 a.m. The only reason for suggesting this alternative is that on the 15th we have two major functions here (i) the unveiling of Sardar's statue by Dr Rajendra Prasad and (ii) the Convocation. Both will be finished by lunch time and we shall have the afternoon to ourselves. From our point of view we would like this so that we have the pleasure of your presence particularly on the occasion of the unveiling of Sardar's statue.

Do drop me a line to indicate what suits you best.
