Dear Shri Peuch,

Thank you very much for your kind letter dated May 23 : 67, which I have just received. We will send you a small quantity of Sharbati Sonora. According to a recent decision of the Government we should give only 2 Kgs. of seeds of a new variety to any single farmer. I am sorry to learn that the U.P. Government is not purchasing seeds of Sonora 64 and Lerma Rojo. The U.P. Agricultural University at Pant Nagar is selling these seeds and you could probably enquire from them whether they would like to take your seeds or refer some of the enquiries to you. Dr. Dharampal Singh, Addl. Director of Agriculture, U.P., told me that they want to spread Sonora 64 in a large area. You could probably also write to him.

As regards paddy, you can try IR-8, which is better than Taichung Native-1. We do not have seeds of this variety, but you can get the same from the National Seeds Corporation. You could write to them in advance so that they keep the seeds ready with them when you come here. Their address is:

Dear Dr Swaminathan,

I hope I do not have to remind you of your promise at the Pusa Flower Show in February - even if this reference itself looks suspiciously like a reminder!- to arrange ma a few quintals of Amber Sonora 64 - not more than ten, and the crop will be entirely at your disposal.

I would prefer obtaining it direct from you and for this reason I have addressed this request to you fairly early so the limited supply is placed with farmers from whom every seed will be recoverable apart from having been grown under optimum conditions of cultivation.

The U.P. Government is, apparently, more concerned with seeds of its own raising, like K 68, with considerably less emphasis on the Mexicans, Lerma Rojo and Sonora 64. If there are requests from any State Governments, I would be grateful if, in case you cannot meet their requirements, you could refer them to me. I have a thousand quintals Sonora 64 and five hundred Lerma Rojo which I am loathe to see lost as foundation seed after all the trouble we have been to in raising these varieties.

I shall be planting a small area of ten acres Taichung Native 1 -if you have another paddy you can recommend even more strongly for our area around Delhi, I shall collect a sample of ten kilos at my next visit within a fortnight.
