I am writing this letter in connection with the decision of I.M.S. to amend its bylaws so as to give only one of its two periodicals free to members. Subsequently the general body meeting held at Kanpur in December, 1975, decided that the amended bylaw should not be applied to life members who have joined I.M.S. prior to the amendment.

Thus you are now entitled to receive both the periodicals free. However I am writing this letter to request you to see if you can voluntarily agree to receive only one of the two periodicals free. I am making such a request to all the life members of our Society. The Society would be indeed very willing and happy to supply both the periodicals free to all its members because the fruits of the activities of the Society should reach all its members and our activities are still limited to only a few fields.

However, as you are aware, the cost of paper and the printing charges have gone up considerably and to add to it, the inland as well as foreign postage rates have been almost doubled.

Under these circumstances, may I request you to forgo receiving one of the two periodicals free for some time to come? If you find it possible to agree my request please let me know which of the two periodicals - THE JOURNAL and THE STUDENT - you would like to receive free of charge. In case you also want the other periodical on making a small payment, please write to the Treasurer who will send you the details which are the same as those applicable to ordinary members.

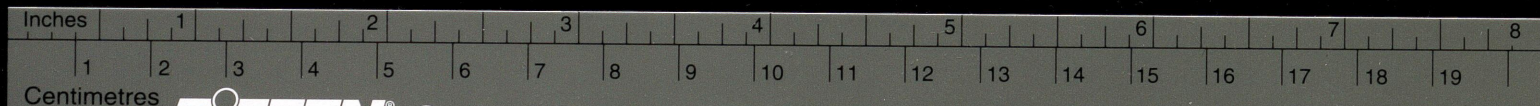
But if for some reasons you find yourself not able to accede to my request please do not hesitate to say so and you will continue to receive both the periodicals free as per decision of the general body of the Society.

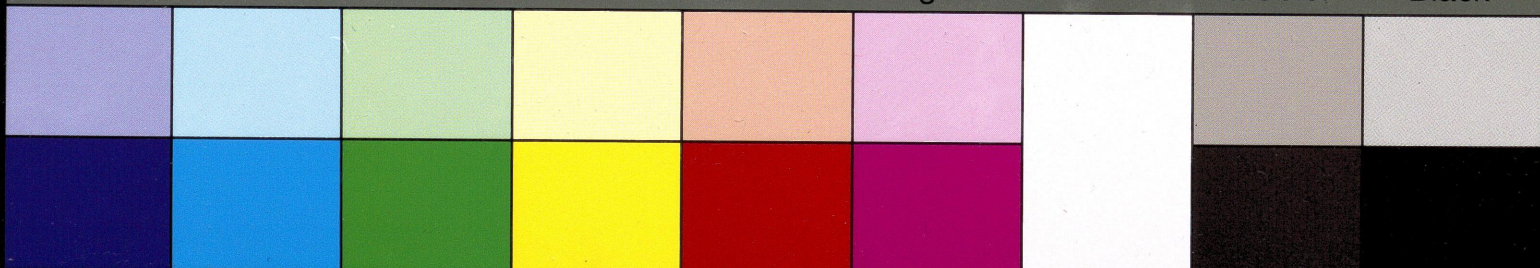

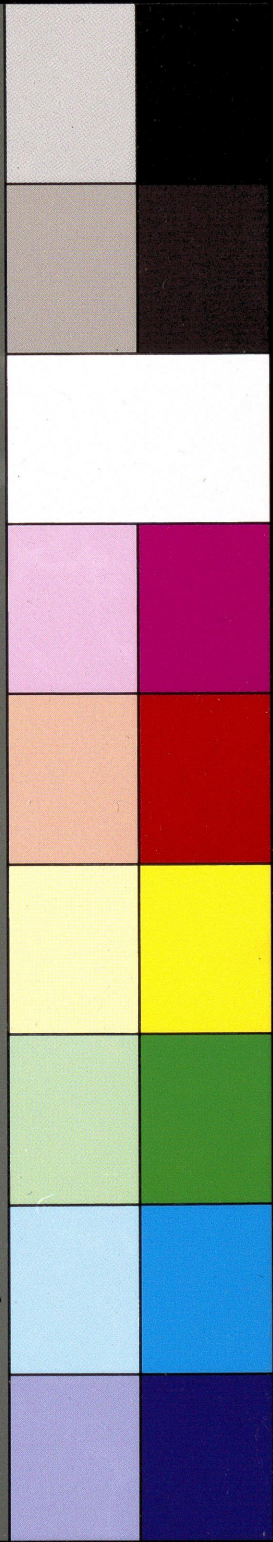

General Circular (25.2.1977)

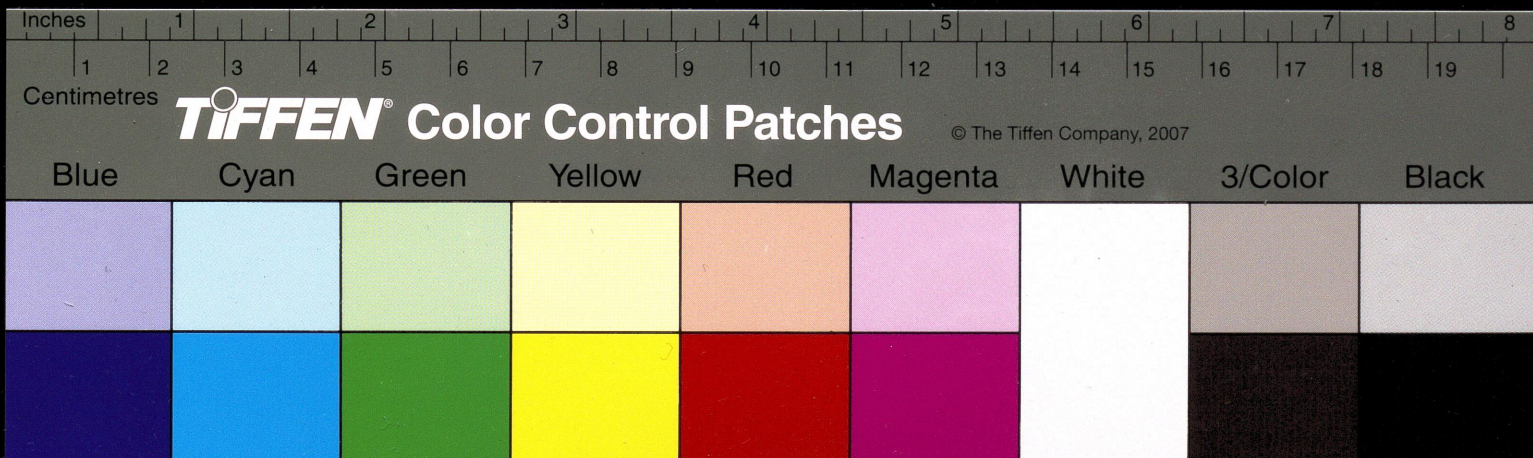

Dear Professor Madhava Rao,

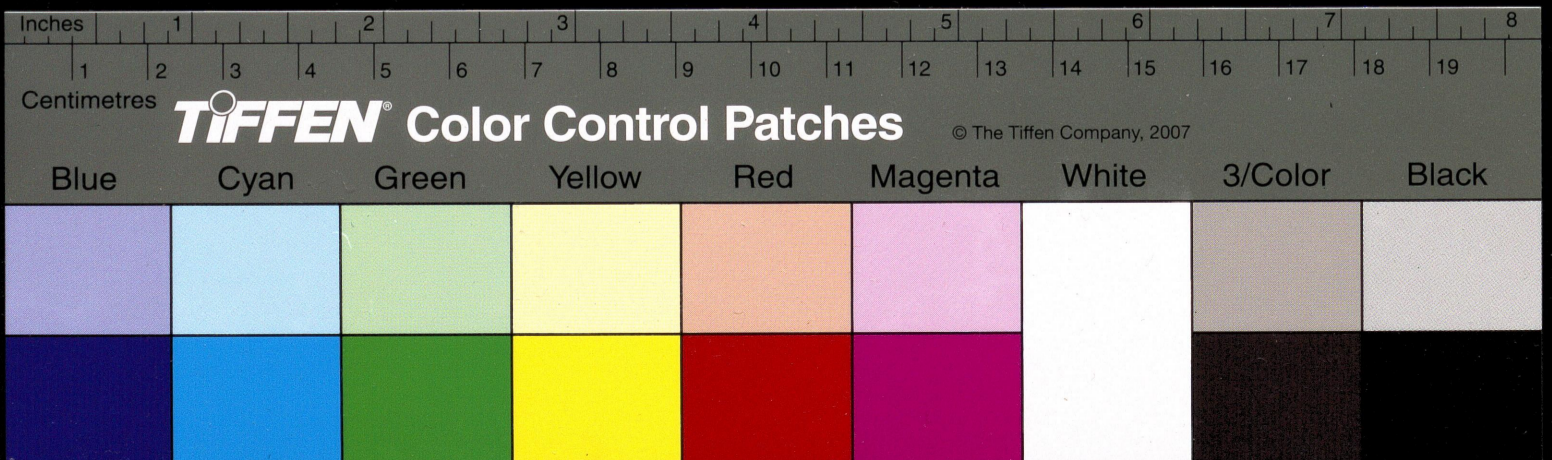

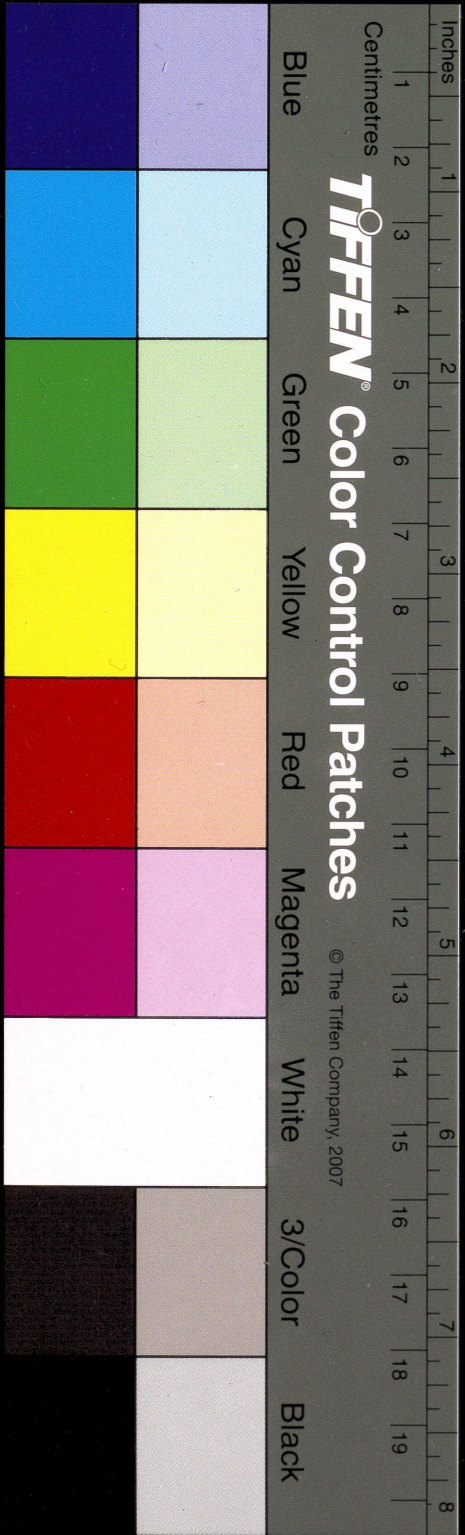
In case you wish to get an advance for the expenses, it can be arranged, say around the start of December.
