Dear Sir:

This has reference to your patient, Sunderlal, Male, 16 years, a case of Myeloid Leukaemia, sent to Western Railway Hospital, Bombay, by you in October, 1967, and was later referred to the Tata Memorial Hospital. This patient is the son of Deoraj Ferumal Khatri, Peon in Locomotive Office at Ajmir.


This case was in turn referred to us by the Tata Memorial Hospital and our investigations showed a suspicion of an abnormality of red cells besides the above condition. In order to confirm this and in response to our request blood samples were kindly collected by your staff from other members of his family and sent to us on 2.12.67. We understand that this patient has since gone back to Ajmir.

I shall be grateful if you will let me know the present condition of this patient and whether he was given any more blood transfusions. Also please let me have a copy of the original laboratory report on him (both - blood and bone marrow) leading to the diagnosis of Myeloid Leukaemia. When the patient came to us he had already had blood transfusions which perhaps had masked the picture. For this reason, I would like to have the original report before treatment started on him.

Hope to receive an early reply.
