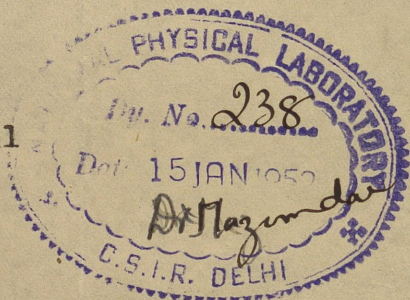

Dear Sir,

We read with pleasure the article about your research in Printing Ink, in today's 'Hindustan Times' and hope that you would further march in other inks viz. Fountain Pen inks etc. The aim of our Works is also to check import from outside.

Recently we have researched typewriter ribbon(ink) which unlike present ribbons never deteriorates in packing and is equally good and lasting as foreign ones and cheaper too. We have been trying to get tape for it from the market and cloth mills, but so far we are unable to get it. We made further research in this respect and found that the used ribbons (undamaged) which are at present thrown in the waste-baskets could be re-inked and can work as good and as long as new ones. The tape of the ribbon can last for 6 months by re-inking. We then wrote to the Controller of Printing and Stationery, Calcutta to introduce the re-inking system in Government offices and he invited quotations from us. We did so and sent to him a sample of re-inked ribbon for trial. It is over 3 months that nothing is heard from him though we have issued 3,4 reminders. We are sure that if re-inking system is introduced in

Government offices, considerable recurring expenditure on ribbons of typewriters will be saved viz. about 50% but if new tape is arranged to us, the expenditure will be further curtailed to 35%.

Our Concern does not get any help from any source and is depending on its turn-over and is ~~is~~ in its infancy.

As you may be interested in such kind of researches, we are approaching you in the matter.

This letter has been typed from a re-inked ribbon, which has already worked over a month.
