Sub: Symposium on Oils, Fats & Allied Products.

You might be aware that the above Symposium had been convened under the auspices of this Chamber sometime during 3rd week of this month and Shri D. P. Karmarkar, Minister of Commerce, Government of India, had agreed to inaugurate the same. We would request the Associations and other Bodies to depute their representatives to attend this Symposium and present a Paper on their relevant subjects. Usually it should not take more than 10 minutes to read a Paper.

The Chamber would be glad to make, on request, necessary accommodation arrangements for persons coming from upcountry centres to attend this Symposium. This would be possible after the fixation of the Symposium programme. Further particulars of the programme would follow from time to time.

A line in reply will be appreciated.


I have pleasure to inform you that the Oil Merchants' Chamber Ltd., is holding a Symposium on Oils, Fats and allied Products on 27th and 28th February, 1953. Shri D.P. Karmarkar, Minister for Commerce, Government of India, has kindly agreed to inaugurate the Symposium.

The forthcoming Symposium is the third of its series, the previous ones having been held under the auspices of Central Laboratories for Scientific and Industrial Research, Hyderabad (Dn) and National Chemical Laboratory of India, Poona, during August 1950 and November 1951 respectively. This Chamber, which has not confined its varied activities to merely trade matters but conducts an analytical Laboratory, publishes since 1948, a pioneer monthly magazine viz., " OILS AND OILSEEDS JOURNAL " and had convened in July 1950 an All India Conference of Associations of Oil Industry and Trade, is the first commercial Organisation to convene a Symposium of this nature.

You would appreciate that such Symposia serve as a meeting ground and provide common platform for Industrialists, Scientists, Businessmen, Technologists, Research workers etc., to discuss modern trends of original investigation.
