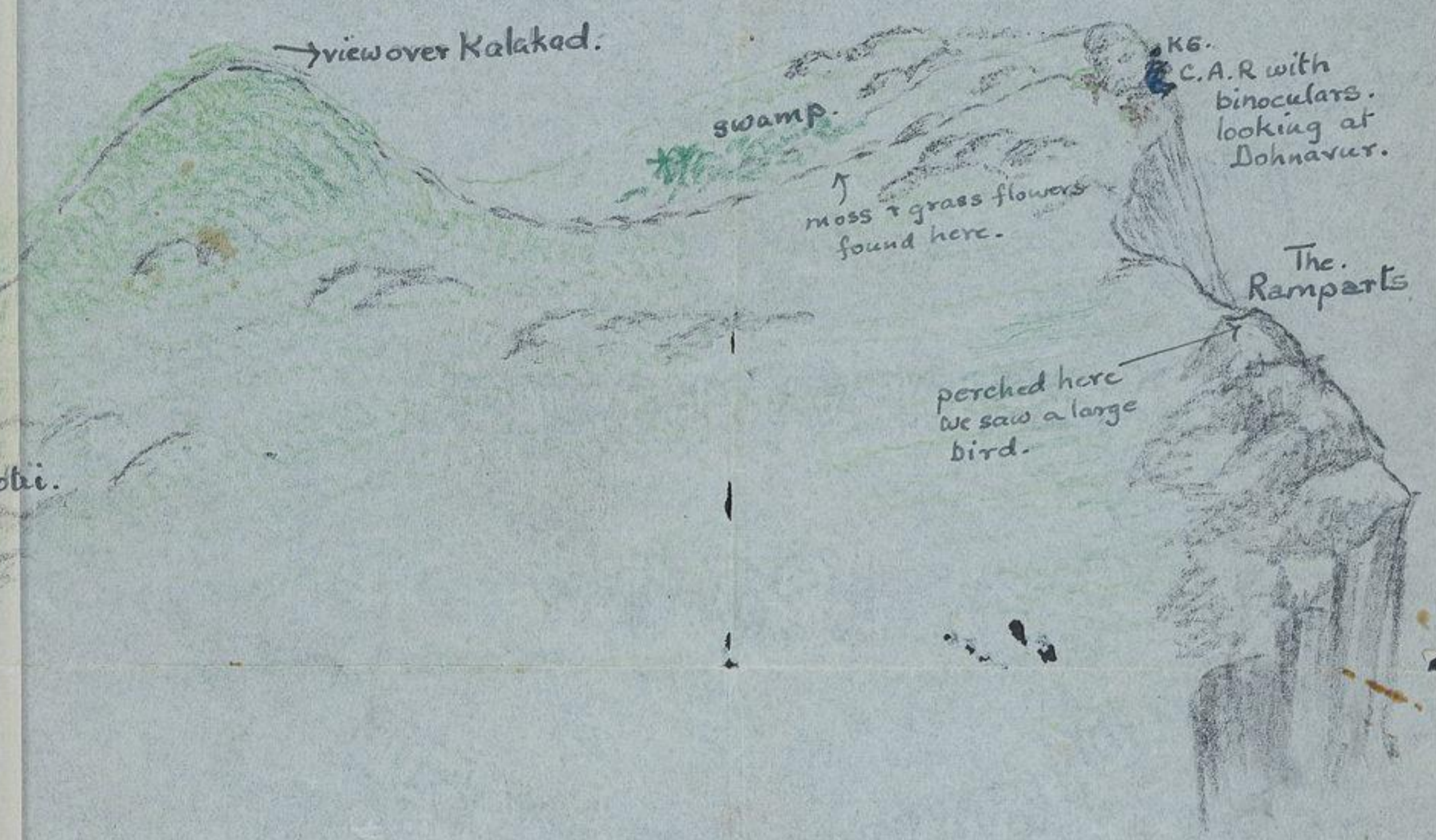
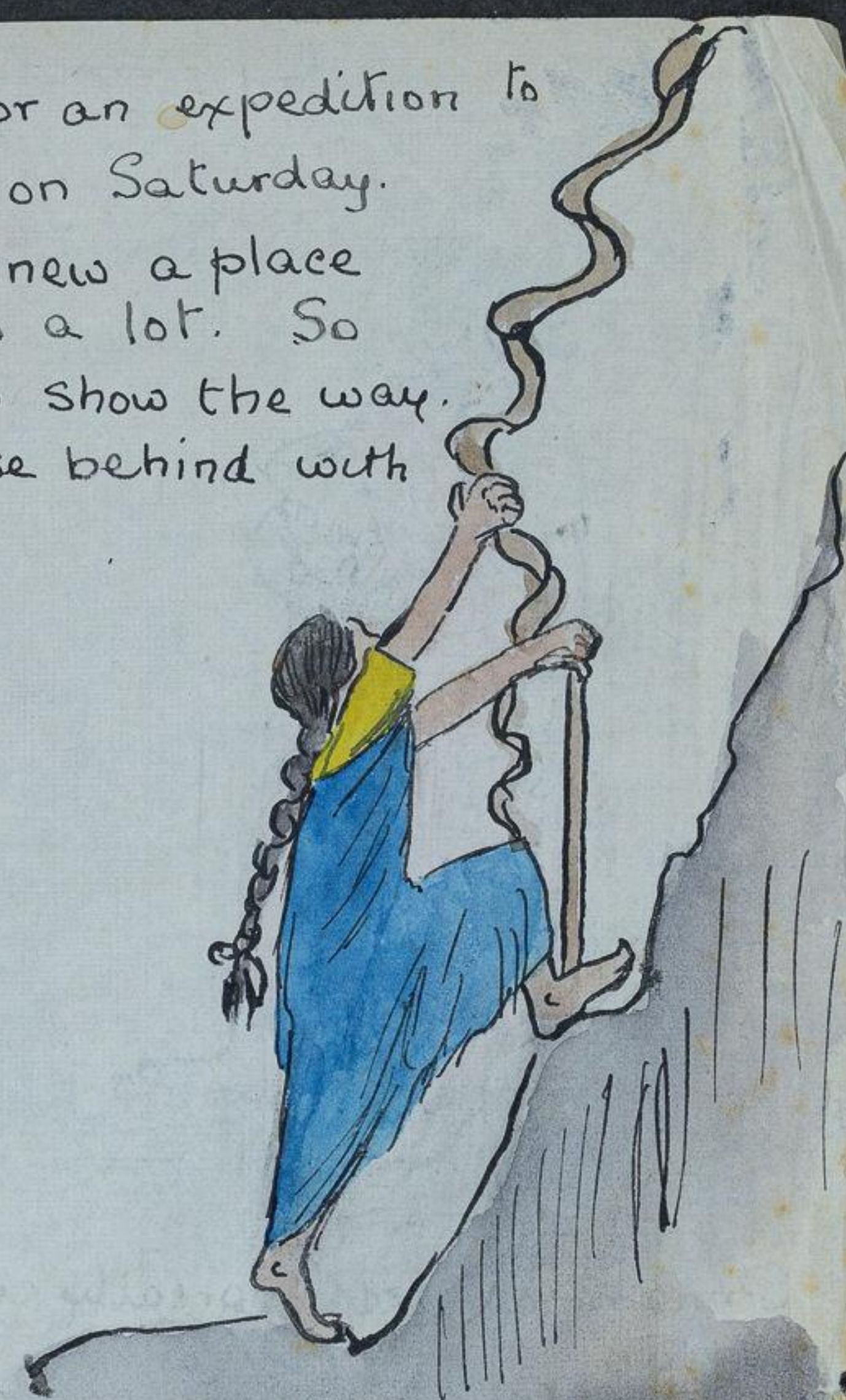


Expedition to the Ramparts. 16.3.39.

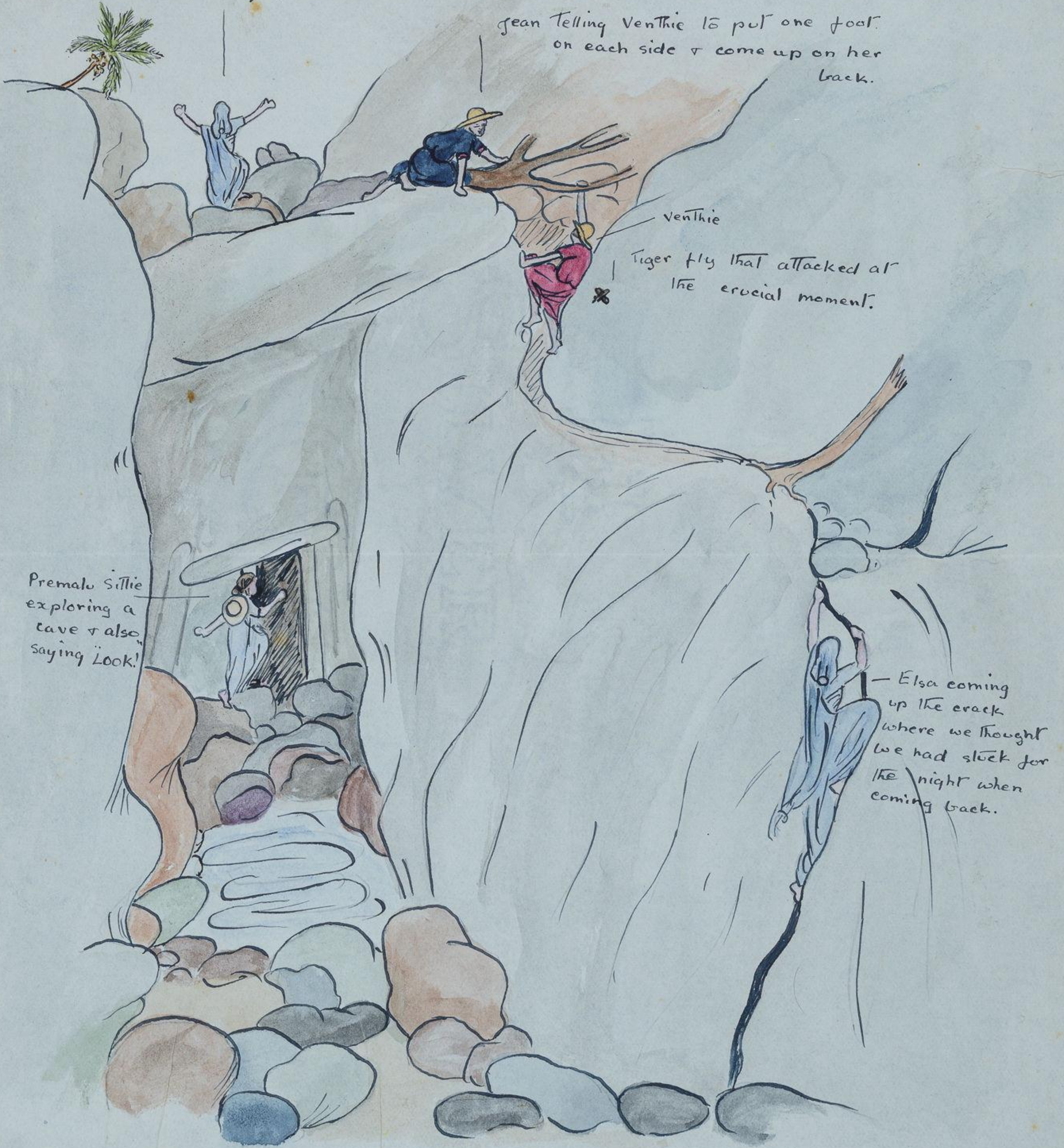
