

second, by sending the paper(s) as early as you can, and in any case before the middle of September 1965. (Since this is an important Seminar, you may perhaps like to send your paper even if you are not able to attend the Seminar.) The papers will be published in a bookform.

We are contacting some scientists from different fields in this connection, but it is quite possible that we may have overlooked some other scientists doing important work of psychological import. We shall therefore be glad to know from you immediately the names and addresses of any such scientists and the studies they are engaged in so that we could request them to join us in the Seminar.

Invited participants and leaders of discussion will be paid two first class fares by rail for the journey, and boarding and lodging will be provided free to them.

I shall be grateful if you write to me your willingness to participate in the Seminar and the topic of your paper, if possible by return of post, or else as very soon as possible.
