
Reference your letter no. ED/7228/69 dated October 11th, 1969, I have to thank you for your kind acceptance of our invitation.

I have already talked to you on telephone, regarding holding of the First National Congress on Human Genetics in Poona on April 10th, 11th and 12th '70, during the time when Professor Victor A. McKusick will be in Poona.

In this connection, we have formed an Organising Committee and we have great pleasure to request you to kindly consent to be a Member. Further as the accompanying papers make it clear, we are planning together with the seminar to organise a workshop, through which it is proposed to exhibit methodology employed in Human Genetics in various sub-sectors in Human Genetics. Dear Professor Mutalik:

This has reference to your letter dated 11th February, 1970.


As explained in my letter dated 13th February 1970, I had forwarded a copy of your letter to Dr. Sanghvi for information and comments. I received a reply from him giving his views. I talked to you on phone on 21st February 1970 and conveyed to you Dr. Sanghvi's views in the matter and what transpired between him and Professor McKusick regarding the forthcoming Genetic Congress in Poona. You were to talk to Professor McKusick on phone and also convey through him to Dr. Sanghvi your views and let me know of the outcome. I was waiting to hear from you..

The First National Congress of Human Genetics should conventionally be organised by a body or an organization and it is not proper to arrange a Congress at this stage when we have no such organisation existing in this country. Under these circumstances, my colleagues and I feel, as Dr. Sanghvi indicated, to name this a Seminar instead of First National Congress. We would, therefore, urge upon you and the organizers to change this into a Seminar and we shall be only too glad to actively participate in it even at this late stage. I hope you do understand our views.

I am even prepared to make a trip to Poona if you so desire to have a discussion on this matter.
