Dear Dr. Krishnan,

I dare say you must have seen my last letter dated 2-11-1953 regarding the appointment of a Director for the Madras Institute of Technology from among the applicants. Mr. M.S. Thacker is out of India at the moment and is expected back on the 10th December at Bangalore. If you are calling for a meeting of the 3 members (yourself, Mr. Thirumalae Iyengar and Mr. Thacker) it will be very helpful if you have the meeting held at Delhi before Christmas, so that your recommendations may be with us before the 1st or 2nd of January. 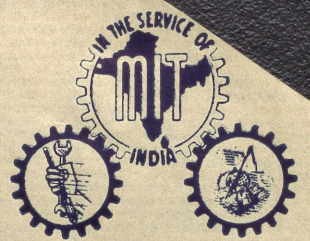

Dear Doctor Krishnan,

After speaking to you on the 'phone this afternoon, I telephoned to Prof. Thacker, Bangalore. He said that 30th and 31st December will not suit him. 25th and 26th December which suits Prof. Thacker, does not suit you. The alternative suggested by Prof. Thacker, to have it after the 3rd of January 1954. You can kindly fix the 4th of January. I am also writing to Prof. Thirumalai Iyengar. Dear Dr. Krishnan,

Shri A.S. Srinivasachari, Correspondent, Hindu High School, Watrap, wrote to me about your generous donation of Rs.7000 for a Science Laboratory to the Hindu High School, Watrap. I understood from him that the school is conducted by a Society, Registered under the Societies Registration Act No.1 of 1911-12, that they keep regular accounts, Balance Sheet, receipts and expenditure account annually. There is no doubt that any donation to the school is free from Income-tax.

As I understand Rs.7000 is to be your contribution, I would suggest your giving Rs.3500 within 31st March 1959 and another Rs.3500 after 1st of April so that you ensure full Incometax rebate on the amounts that you pay.

I have also sent a draft to Sri Srinivasachari to send it to the Commissioner of Incometax/Incometax Officer so that if that certificate is sent to you you may use it in your Incometax assessment when you send your return in April or May 1959 and get Incometax rebate on the donation without any delay.
