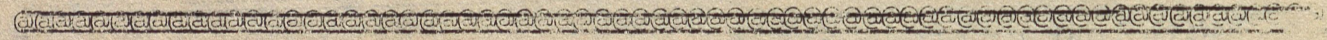

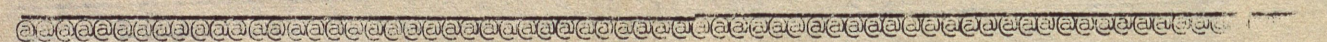




The Subject for this month's competition is "O P E N"

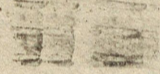

The adjacent village Karman Gatta also houses an old temple complex dedicated to Lord Hanuman.
