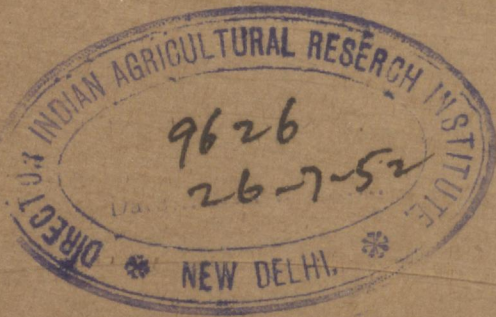

I beg to state that I have been served with one month's notice of termination of my services as Junior Scientific Assistant by the Superintendent, Cattle-Cum-Dairy Farm, Karnal, from 16.7.1952. I am informed that this has been done as a measure of economy under the orders of the Government of India.

I may in this connection bring to your kind notice that I am a permanent displaced Government servant from Sind Agricultural Department (West Pakistan). I am Matriculate and have served in Sind Agricultural Department from 1.4.1937 to March 1948. I joined as J.S.A at Agricultural Substation, Karnal in October 1948. I worked there till March 1951 when I was transferred to the newly set up of Cattle-Cum-Dairy Farm, Karnal. It is understood that as my superior officers were pleased with my work, I was recommended for my retaintion as J.S.A in the I.A.R.I. In the interest of Government work, I was transferred to the Cattle-Cum-Dairy Farm.

Considering my qualification and experience and impending loss of my post of J.S.A in the Farm, it would be a great help if I am provided with a suitable post of J.S.A in the I.A.R.I.

I appeal to you for sympathetic consideration of my case. I am a poor man. I have to support a family of consisting of 7 members and besides to bear the expenses on education of my four children.

For the above act of kindness I shall ever remain grateful.
